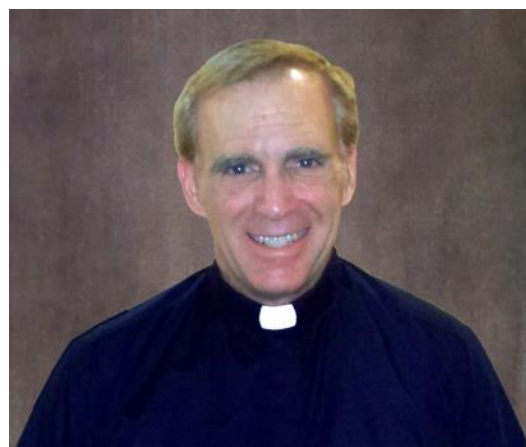

Parish Elections

At the end of this month or early June we will be holding elections for a new Treasurer Trustee and new members of the Parish Pastoral Council. Here is a description of the role of Parish Pastoral Council as well as the Treasure Trustee:

The Parish Pastoral Counsel

The purpose of the Parish Pastoral Council is to assist the Pastor/Administrator in his role of guiding and leading the parish. By means of the council the members of the parish promote the well-being of the parish and foster its mission. Specifically, the Parish Pastoral Council should:

1. Express in a Parish Mission Statement the vision and values of the parish.
2. Translate that Mission Statement into action by establishing a priority of goals and by setting policies to guide parish life.
3. Mobilize the resources (personnel, finances and facilities) of the parish to achieve those goals most effectively.
4. Encourage all members of the parish to participate in the life of the parish.
5. Evaluate efforts, services and achievements.
6. The Secretary Trustee is a member of the Parish Pastoral Council.

A member of the Parish Pastoral Council is elected for a 3-year term. If they desire they can be reelected once for a total of six consecutive years.

Treasurer Trustee

A parish trustee is an active, responsible parish member who is called to serve the parish as an advisor, overseer, and counselor. The responsibilities of the Treasurer Trustee include:

1. Represents the parish as a member of the parish corporation
2. Assists the Administrator/Pastor in the keeping of accurate and detailed accounts of all receipts and disbursements of parish funds following the Diocesan Chart of Account for reporting operations of the parish.
3. Reviews and signs all check for disbursements of parish funds as needed.
4. Assists the Administrator/Pastor in the collection of parish contributions, special collections and parish investments.
5. Reviews and annual parish budget together with the Administrator/Pastor.
6. Assists the Administrator/Pastor in assuring the preparation of financial reports to the parish and diocese.
7. Signs the annual financial report to the diocese.
8. Serves as a full member of the Finance Council and receives parish Pastoral Council minutes.
9. Assists the Administrator/Pastor in overseeing the temporal matters of the parish cemetery.

A trustee is elected for a 2-year term. If they desire they can be reelected twice for a total of six consecutive years.

If you are interested in being a candidate for Parish Pastoral Council or Treasurer Trustee, or know of someone who would, please write your or their name on the nomination slip and put it in the box on the table in the Gathering Space. Thank you for your help and interest in serving your parish.

Ascension Mass

Throughout the Church this Thursday, 30 May, is the Solemnity of the Ascension. Here in the Green Bay Diocese, as well as in many dioceses in the United States, the observance of it is transferred to the following Sunday, 2 June. An exception though is allowed for those Catholics who prefer to worship using the Extraordinary Form of the Mass, also known as the Tridentine Latin Mass. We will celebrate a Tridentine Latin Mass for the Ascension on Thursday, 30 May, at 9:00 A.M. for the people in our area who prefer to worship using this venerable rite. Anyone else who would like to attend is more than welcome.

Las Elecciones Parroquiales

Al final de este mes o principios de junio vamos a tener elecciones para un nuevo Tesorero Fideicomisario y nuevos miembros del Consejo Pastoral Parroquial. Aquí está una descripción del papel del Consejo Pastoral Parroquial, así como el Fideicomisario del Tesoro:

El Consejero Pastoral Parroquial

El propósito del Consejo Pastoral Parroquial es ayudar al Pastor/Administrador en su papel de guiar y dirigir la parroquia. A través del concilio, los miembros de la parroquia promueven el bienestar de la parroquia y fomentan su misión. Específicamente, el Consejo Pastoral Parroquial debería:

1. Expresar en una Declaración de Misión Parroquial la visión y los valores de la parroquia.
2. Traducir esa declaración de misión en acción estableciendo una prioridad de metas y estableciendo políticas para guiar la vida parroquial.
3. Movilizar los recursos (personal, finanzas e instalaciones) de la parroquia para lograr esos objetivos de manera más eficaz.
4. Animar a todos los miembros de la parroquia a participar en la vida de la parroquia.
5. Evaluar esfuerzos, servicios y logros.
6. El Secretario Fiduciario es miembro del Consejo Pastoral Parroquial.

Un miembro del Consejo pastoral parroquial es elegido por un período de 3 años. Si lo desean pueden ser reelegidos una vez por un total de seis años consecutivos.

Tesorero Fiduciario

Un fideicomisario parroquial es un miembro activo y responsable de la parroquia que está llamado a servir a la parroquia como asesor, supervisor y consejero. Las responsabilidades Del Tesorero Fiduciario incluyen:

1. Representa a la parroquia como miembro de la corporación parroquial
2. Asiste al Administrador/Pastor en el mantenimiento de cuentas precisas y detalladas de todos los recibos y desembolsos de los fondos parroquiales después de la Carta de Cuenta Diocesana para la notificación de las operaciones de la parroquia.
3. Revisa y firma todos los cheques para los desembolsos de fondos parroquiales según sea necesario.
4. Asiste al Administrador/Pastor en la colección de contribuciones parroquiales, colecciones especiales e inversiones parroquiales.
5. Revisiones y presupuesto anual de la parroquia junto con el Administrador/Pastor.
6. Asiste al administrador/pastor para asegurar la preparación de informes financieros a la parroquia y diócesis.
7. Firma el informe financiero anual a la diócesis.
8. Servir como miembro completo del Consejo de Finanzas y recibe actas del Consejo Pastoral Parroquial.
9. Asiste al Administrador/Pastor en la supervisión de los asuntos temporales del cementerio parroquial.

Un fideicomisario es elegido por un período de 2 años. Si lo desean, pueden ser reelegidos dos veces por un total de seis años consecutivos.

Si usted está interesado en ser un candidato para el Consejo Pastoral Parroquial o Tesorero Fideicomisario, o saber de alguien que lo haría, por favor escriba su nombre en la hoja de nominación y ponerlo en la caja en la mesa en el espacio de reunión. Gracias por su ayuda e interés en servir a su parroquia.

En toda la Iglesia este jueves, 30 de mayo, es la Solemnidad de la Ascensión. Aquí en la Diócesis de Green Bay, así como en muchas diócesis en los Estados Unidos, la observancia de la misma se transfiere al siguiente domingo 2 de junio. Una excepción, sin embargo, es permitida para aquellos católicos que prefieren adorar usando la Forma Extraordinaria de la Misa, también conocida como la Misa Latina Tridentina. Celebraremos una Misa Latina Tridentina para la Ascensión el Jueves, 30 de mayo, a las 9:00 A.M. para las personas de nuestra zona que prefieren adorar con este venerable rito. Cualquier otra persona que quiera asistir es más que bienvenida.

Tendremos una Misa especial el Día de la Conmemoración, el **lunes 27 de mayo, a las 8:00 A.M.** Todos están invitados a orar ese día por los miembros fallecidos de nuestras fuerzas armadas y por la paz y el fin de los conflictos armados en nuestro mundo.

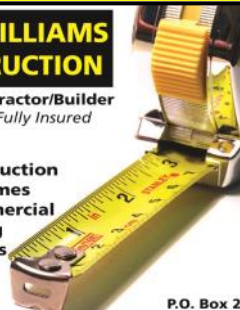
