As the 4th of July approaches we thought it would be good to reprint this article titled: ***A Prayer for Government*** by Scott P. Richert, on the *ThoughtCo* website, dated June 4, 2017:



Archbishop John Carroll was the cousin of Charles Carroll, one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. In 1789, Pope Pius VI named him the first bishop of the United States. He also founded Georgetown University in Washington, D.C. Archbishop Carroll wrote this prayer on November 10, 1791, to be recited in parishes throughout his diocese. It still has special relevance at any time when our government and political consciousness is plagued by division.

“We pray, Thee O Almighty and Eternal God! Who through Jesus Christ hast revealed Thy glory to all nations, to preserve the works of Thy mercy, that Thy Church, being spread through the whole world, may continue with unchanging faith in the confession of Thy Name.

We pray Thee, who alone art good and holy, to endow with heavenly knowledge, sincere zeal, and sanctity of life, our chief bishop, Pope *N.*, the Vicar of Our Lord Jesus Christ, in the government of his Church; our own bishop, *N.*, all other bishops, prelates, and pastors of the Church; and especially those who are appointed to exercise amongst us the functions of the holy ministry, and conduct Thy people into the ways of salvation.

We pray Thee O God of might, wisdom, and justice! Through whom authority is rightly administered, laws are enacted, and judgment decreed, assist with Thy Holy Spirit of counsel and fortitude the President of these United States, that his administration may be conducted in righteousness, and be eminently useful to Thy people over whom he presides; by encouraging due respect for virtue and religion; by a faithful execution of the laws in justice and mercy; and by restraining vice and immorality. Let the light of Thy divine wisdom direct the deliberations of Congress, and shine forth in all the proceedings and laws framed for our rule and government, so that they may tend to the preservation of peace, the promotion of national happiness, the increase of industry, sobriety, and useful knowledge; and may perpetuate to us the blessing of equal liberty.

We pray for his excellency, the governor of this state, for the members of the assembly, for all judges, magistrates, and other officers who are appointed to guard our political welfare, that they may be enabled, by Thy powerful protection, to discharge the duties of their respective stations with honesty and ability. We recommend likewise, to Thy unbounded mercy, all our brethren and fellow citizens throughout the United States, that they may be blessed in the knowledge and sanctified in the observance of Thy most holy law; that they may be preserved in union, and in that peace which the world cannot give; and after enjoying the blessings of this life, be admitted to those which are eternal.

Finally, we pray to Thee, O Lord of mercy, to remember the souls of Thy servants departed who are gone before us with the sign of faith and repose in the sleep of peace; the souls of our parents, relatives, and friends; of those who, when living, were members of this congregation, and particularly of such as are lately deceased; of all benefactors who, by their donations or legacies to this Church, witnessed their zeal for the decency of divine worship and proved their claim to our grateful and charitable remembrance. To these, O Lord, and to all that rest in Christ, grant, we beseech Thee, a place of refreshment, light, and everlasting peace, through the same Jesus Christ, Our Lord and Savior. Amen.”

El Arzobispo John Carroll era el primo de Charles Carroll, uno de los firmantes de la declaración de la independencia. En 1789, el Papa Pío VI lo nombró el primer obispo de los Estados Unidos. También fundó la Universidad de Georgetown en Washington, D.C. El arzobispo Carroll escribió esta oración el 10 de noviembre de 1791, para ser recitada en parroquias a través de su diócesis. Todavía tiene especial relevancia en cualquier momento cuando nuestro gobierno y la conciencia política están plagados por la división.

"Oremos, Ti Oh Todopoderoso y eterno Dios! Que por medio de Jesucristo has revelado tu gloria a todas las Naciones, para preservar las obras de tu misericordia, para que tu iglesia, siendo esparcida por todo el mundo, pueda continuar con fe inmutable en la confesión de tu nombre.

Te rogamos, que sólo el arte bueno y Santo, para dotar con el conocimiento celestial, el celo sincero, y la santidad de la vida, nuestro obispo en jefe, el Papa N., el Vicario de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, en el gobierno de su iglesia; nuestro propio Obispo, N., todos los Alfiles, los prelate y los pastores de la iglesia; y especialmente aquellos que son designados para ejercitar entre nosotros las funciones del santo ministerio, y conducir a tu pueblo a los caminos de la salvación.

Te rogamos oh Dios de la fuerza, la sabiduría y la justicia! A través de quien se administra con razón la autoridad, se promulgan leyes y se decreta el juicio, ayuda con tu Espíritu Santo de Consejo y fortaleza al Presidente de estos Estados Unidos, para que su administración pueda ser conducida en rectitud, y sea eminentemente útil para Tu pueblo sobre el que preside; fomentando el debido respeto a la virtud y a la religión; por una fiel ejecución de las leyes en la justicia y la misericordia; y por el vicio de restricción y la inmoralidad. Que la luz de tu divina sabiduría dirija las deliberaciones del Congreso, y brille en todos los procedimientos y leyes enmarcados para nuestra regla y gobierno, para que puedan tender a la preservación de la paz, la promoción de la felicidad nacional, el aumento de la industria, sobriedad y conocimiento útil; y nos puede perpetuar la bendición de la igualdad de libertad.

Oremos por su excelencia, el gobernador de este estado, por los miembros de la Asamblea, por todos los jueces, magistrados, y otros oficiales que son designados para proteger nuestro bienestar político, para que puedan ser habilitados, por tu poderosa protección, para cumplir con los deberes de sus respectivas estaciones con honestidad y habilidad. Recomendamos igualmente, a tu misericordia ilimitada, a todos nuestros hermanos y conciudadanos en todo Estados Unidos, que sean bendecidos en el conocimiento y santificados en la observancia de tu Santísima ley; que puedan ser preservados en la Unión, y en esa paz que el mundo no puede dar; y después de disfrutar de las bendiciones de esta vida, ser admitido a los que son eternos.

Por último, te rogamos, oh Señor de la misericordia, que recuerdes las almas de tus siervos que se han ido delante de nosotros con el signo de la fe y el reposo en el sueño de la paz; las almas de nuestros padres, parientes y amigos; de los que, cuando vivían, eran miembros de esta congregación, y particularmente de tales como son últimamente difuntos; de todos los benefactores que, por sus donaciones o legados a esta iglesia, presenciaron su celo por la decencia del culto divino y demostraron su afirmación de nuestro agradecimiento y caridad.
