Evergreen Campsite will again have train rides, a big thank you to them!



#### **Thoughts on Pentecost**

Here is an excerpt from an article titled: "Making room for the Holy Spirit entails daily battle against (the) devil, Pope says", by Carol Glatz of the Catholic News Service, dated 26 October 2017, on *The Catholic Register* website:

Being a Christian means battling the devil and striving for holiness each day, Pope Francis said.

"Jesus calls us to change our lives, change paths, calls us to conversion," he said in his homily at Mass in the Domus Sanctae Marthae Oct. 26.

There is no such thing as Christians who are resting easy, "who do not fight," he said.

Conversion isn't about superficial change, like applying makeup, the pope said; it requires a change within that has been brought about by the Holy Spirit.

When Jesus tells his disciples in the day's Gospel reading (Lk 12:49-53) that "I have come to set the earth on fire and how I wish it were already blazing," he is speaking of a fire that requires that people change the way they think and feel, the pope said.

"Your heart that was worldly, pagan, now becomes Christian with Christ's strength," he said, and the way one behaves also changes because conversion "involves everything – body and soul."

"I have to do my part so that the Holy Spirit can act and this means a battle, to battle" and to make room for the Holy Spirit in one's heart, the pope said. That requires an examination of conscience every day and fighting against the various "diseases" the devil sows, "the diseases of worldliness."

"Ask ourselves every day: how have I gone from worldliness, from sin to grace?" the pope suggested. "Have I made room for the Holy Spirit so that he could act?"

"Difficulties in our life are not resolved by watering down the truth. The truth is this: Jesus has brought fire and fights, what I have done?"

Those Christians who take it easy are "lukewarm" and their tranquillity should not be confused with real inner peace that only the Holy Spirit can bring – "that peace for the soul that gives Christians strength," the Pope said.

#### Pensamientos sobre Pentecostés

Aquí hay un extracto de un artículo titulado: "Hacer espacio para el Espíritu Santo implica la batalla diaria contra (el) diablo, dice Papa", por Carol Glatz del Servicio Católico de Noticias, de fecha 26 de octubre de 2017, en el sitio web del *Registro Católico*:

Ser cristiano significa luchar contra el diablo y esforzarse por la santidad cada día, dijo el Papa Francisco.

"Jesús nos llama a cambiar nuestras vidas, cambiar caminos, nos llama a la conversión", dijo en su homilía en la Misa en la Domus Sanctae Marthae, 26 de octubre.

No hay tal cosa como los cristianos que están descansando fácil, "que no luchan, ", dijo.

La conversión no es sobre el cambio superficial, como la aplicación del maquillaje, dijo el Papa; requiere un cambio dentro del cual ha sido provocado por el Espíritu Santo.

Cuando Jesús dice a sus discípulos en la lectura del evangelio del día (LC 12:49-53) que "he venido a poner la tierra en fuego y cómo desearía que ya estuviera ardiendo", está hablando de un incendio que requiere que la gente cambie la forma en que piensan y sienten, dijo el Papa.

"Su corazón que era mundano, pagano, ahora se convierte en cristiano con la fuerza de Cristo," dijo, y la forma en que uno se comporta también cambia porque la conversión "involucra todo-cuerpo y alma."

"Tengo que hacer mi parte para que el Espíritu Santo pueda actuar y esto significa una batalla, a la batalla " y para hacer espacio para el Espíritu Santo en el corazón de uno, dijo el Papa. Eso requiere un examen de conciencia todos los días y luchando contra los diversos "enfermedades " el demonio siembra, "las enfermedades de la mundanidad."

"Pregúntémonos todos los días: ¿Cómo he ido de lo mundano, del pecado a la gracia? " sugirió el Papa. "¿He hecho espacio para el Espíritu Santo para que él pueda actuar? "

"Las dificultades en nuestra vida no se resuelven diluyendo la verdad. La verdad es esta: Jesús ha traído fuego y peleas, lo que he hecho? "

Aquellos cristianos que lo toman con calma son "tibia" y su tranquilidad no debe confundirse con la paz interior real que sólo el Espíritu Santo puede traer -"que la paz para el alma que da fuerza a los cristianos, " dijo el Papa.




