

Reflection on the Our Father

Here is an excerpt from an article titled: "This is the prayer granted us on the day of our baptism," by Kathleen N. Hattrup, dated 14 March 2018, on the *Aleteia* website:

"It is so beautiful to pray like Jesus!"

The "Our Father" is the prayer granted to us on the day of our baptism, which causes to resonate in us the same feelings that were in Jesus. "Jesus prayed in this way. It is so beautiful to pray like Jesus!"

This was Pope Francis' reflection on the "*prayer of the children of God*," which he considered today during the general audience, as he continued with his catechesis series on the Mass.

"This is not one of the many Christian prayers, but rather it is *the prayer of the children of God*: It is the great prayer that Jesus taught us," he said. "When we pray with the 'Our Father,' we pray as Jesus prayed," the pope reflected. "It is the prayer that Jesus recited, and taught to us, when the disciples said to Him, 'Master, teach us to pray as you pray.""

"Formed in His divine teaching, we dare turn to God calling him 'Father' ... No one, in truth, could call him familiarly '*Abba'* – Father – without having been generated by God, without the inspiration of the Spirit," he said.

Francis reflected how so often, people say "Our Father" without knowing what they say, without feeling that God truly is their father. "Do you have a relationship with this Father?" Francis asked...

The pope went on to speak of the petitions in the Lord's Prayer, including "forgive us our trespasses." "Forgiving people who have offended us is not easy; it is a grace that we must ask for: 'Lord, teach us to forgive as You have forgiven me.' It is a grace. With our strength we cannot do it: to forgive is a grace of the Holy Spirit," he said...

And the pope concluded with the invitation that we not forget the Our Father, the prayer Jesus taught us, and with which "He prayed to the Father."

"And (at Mass) this prayer prepares us for Communion."

Reflexión sobre el Padre Nuestro

Aquí hay un extracto de un artículo titulado: **"Esta es la oración que nos concedió el día de nuestro bautismo"**, por Kathleen N. Hattrup, fechada el 14 de marzo de 2018, en el sitio web de Aleteia:

"Es tan hermoso orar como Jesús! "



El "Padre Nuestro" es la oración que se nos ha concedido el día de nuestro bautismo, que (hace que resuene en nosotros los mismos sentimientos que había en Jesús. "Jesús oró de

esta manera. ¡Es tan hermoso orar como Jesús!" Esta fue la reflexión del Papa Francisco sobre la "oración de los hijos de Dios", que consideró hoy durante la audiencia general, mientras continuaba con su serie de catequesis sobre la misa.

"Esta no es una de las muchas oraciones cristianas, sino más bien es la oración de los hijos de Dios: Es la gran oración que Jesús nos enseñó", dijo.

"Cuando oramos con el 'Padre Nuestro', oramos mientras Jesús oraba", reflexionó el Papa. "Es la oración que Jesús recita, y nos enseñó, cuando los discípulos le dijeron: 'Maestro, enséñanos a orar mientras oras'".

"Formados en Su enseñanza divina, nos atrevemos a volvernos a Dios llamándolo 'Padre'... Nadie, en verdad, podría llamarlo familiarmente '*Abba*' – Padre – sin haber sido generado por Dios, sin la inspiración del Espíritu", dijo.

Francisco reflexionó con la frecuencia, la gente dice "Padre Nuestro" sin saber lo que dicen, sin sentir que Dios es verdaderamente su padre. "¿Tienes una relación con este Padre?" Francisco preguntó...

El Papa continuó hablando de las peticiones en la Oración del Señor, incluyendo "perdónanos nuestras ofensas". "Perdonar a las personas que nos han ofendido no es fácil; es una gracia que debemos pedir: 'Señor, enséñanos a perdonar como tú me has perdonado'. Es una gracia. Con nuestra fuerza no podemos hacerlo: perdonar es una gracia del Espíritu Santo", dijo...

Y el Papa concluyó con la invitación de que no olvidemos al Padre Nuestro, la oración que Jesús nos enseñó, y con la que "oró al Padre".

"Y (en la misa) esta oración nos prepara para la Comunión."
