



#### The Ministry of Altar Servers

Here at St. Joseph Parish we are making a concerted effort to attract more young people, particularly boys and teens, to the ministry of Altar Serving. We hope we can be successful in doing so because it is such an important ministry. One of the ways we will do this is by running articles in the bulletin regarding Altar Serving. This one is taken from the websites of St. Bridget Catholic Church in Richmond, VA and St. Luke Catholic Church in Temple, TX.



Along with the priest, deacons, and all liturgical ministers, Altar Servers help lead the assembly in the worship of God. The Real Presence of Christ in the liturgy is revealed to the congregation, in part, through those who commit to Altar Serving. As they lead the processional, Altar Servers guide the people of God into His presence. By their demeanor, appearance, and reverence in handling the sacred vessels, candles, and holy books, altar servers demonstrate to the people their love and devotion for what they do. As they go about their tasks in a careful and reverent way, they help those who watch them to pray more deeply.

Altar Servers are not the objects of the congregation's attention. Instead, they are guides to help highlight the Real Presence of Christ by executing their duties with respect, honor, and humble dignity.

At St. Joseph Parish we hope to form a group of young people who assist the priests and deacons by serving on the altar in a prayerful manner during Holy Mass. It is an extreme privilege to kneel so close to the altar as our loving Savior, Jesus Christ, becomes truly present, body, blood, soul, and divinity, at the moment of Consecration. An Altar Server is uniquely joined in the Heavenly Supper of the Lamb and serves in the company of those eternally singing, "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!" An Altar Server has a solemn responsibility to do the assigned duties with attention, dignity, and reverence

There are several duties involved with being an Altar Server; however, the most important is that of prayer leader. As an Altar Server, you will help those attending Mass to listen. Nothing you do will be a distraction to those who are trying so hard to hear. You will help the service flow smoothly so that the congregation can



concentrate on all the wonderful sounds surrounding them: the music, the priest's prayers, and the words of Scripture. With your help, their time of worship will be more meaningful. You will be responding along with everyone else, praying and singing, so when people see you participating so actively in the Mass, they will feel more comfortable about joining in themselves. As you can see, Altar Servers have an important leadership role in the celebration of Mass.

#### El Ministerio de Monaguillos

Aquí, en la Parroquia de San José, estamos haciendo un esfuerzo concertado para atraer a más jóvenes, en particular niños y adolescentes, al ministerio de Monaguillos. Esperamos que podamos tener éxito en hacerlo porque es un ministerio tan importante. Una de las maneras en que lo haremos es publicando artículos en el boletín sobre Servicio de Altar. Este está tomado de los sitios web de La Iglesia Católica de Santa Bridget en Richmond, VA y La Iglesia Católica de San Lucas en Temple, TX.



Junto con el sacerdote, los diáconos y todos los ministros litúrgicos, los Monaguillos ayudan a dirigir la asamblea en la adoración de Dios. La presencia real de Cristo en la liturgia se revela a la congregación, en parte, a través de aquellos que se comprometen con el Servicio de Altar. Por su comportamiento, apariencia y reverencia en el manejo de los vasos sagrados, velas y libros sagrados, los servidores de altares demuestran al pueblo su amor y devoción por lo que hacen. A medida que llevan a sus tareas de una manera cuidadosa y reverente, ayudan a quienes los observan a orar más profundamente.

Los Monaguillos no son los objetos de la atención de la congregación. En cambio, son guías para ayudar a resaltar la Presencia Real de Cristo al ejecutar sus deberes con respeto, honor y dignidad humilde.
