ASK A CATHOLIC

An atheist tells me that the original Gospels were never found and they are based on word of mouth accounts.

First, remind your atheist friend that original copies of Plato, Aristotle, and Homer's works don't exist, yet no credible historian questions their historical authenticity, including whether these prominent ancient men wrote their respective works. Similarly, while we don't have the original copies of the Gospels, we do have rather early manuscripts and fragments, and many when compared to the number of other ancient written works.

In addition, St. Matthew and St. John were eyewitnesses to the life of Jesus, and St. Mark and St. Luke relied on the reports of eyewitnesses.

In addition, explain to your atheist friend that the Catholic Church does not rely on the Bible alone, given that the Church existed for decades before all of the New Testament books were written and centuries before they were compiled into the New Testament canon—not to mention that members of the Church wrote the New Testament books, and Church authorities determined that they were indeed inspired by the Holy Spirit and thus worthy of inclusion in the biblical canon. There's no doubt that the Catholic Church existed from the time of Jesus, as various historical sources, Christian and non-Christian, attest.

Article: Marriage, Pornography and Fornication By Nate Guyear (Part 3 of 9)

Statement: "As long as everyone involved is a consenting adult, then there's nothing wrong with pornography or pre-marital sex."

Answer: The argument here is that consent makes an action right. But what if I asked someone to kill or mutilate me and that person consented to do it? Does consent make these actions right? Unfortunately, some today would say, "Yes." Clearly, however, this line of reasoning has flaws. Natural law and God's word prohibit fornication and adultery whether or not consent is present. Similarly, intentionally watching others engage in these sins would also be wrong.

Turning to natural law, we see that all our faculties (abilities) are directed toward an end, even if that end is never realized due to deformity. Our digestive systems are designed to receive food and drink for nutrition purposes. Our legs and feet are designed to move us from one point to another. Our hands grasp things and aid us in conversations. If we were to remove our digestive systems (or drink poison), or cut off our feet, legs and hands, we would be intentionally frustrating the ends toward which these faculties are intended. Our sexual organs, and, thus, sex itself are directed toward a particular end, union and procreation, even if that end is never realized. Sperm is always ordered toward fertilizing a woman's ovum. The ovum is always ordered toward the reception of sperm. The sexual union of man and woman is the natural means of achieving the end for our reproductive system, a system that is only complete when a man and woman unite sexually. Since human sexual intercourse is aimed at procreation, and the products of procreation, children, need a mother (nurturer) and father (protector) to continue the work they began in sex, then a permanent, committed relationship between a potential mother and father is necessary. "A parent of each sex is necessary to raise the child, because the male is better suited to protection and the female is better suited to nurture. A parent of each sex is necessary to teach the child, because the child needs a model of his own sex, a model of the other sex and a model of the relationship between them. Mom and dad are jointly irreplaceable." Further, sexual pleasure is good, but it is not the end of the sexual act. It merely provides motivation for the sexual act, which must always be directed toward its proper end.

Premarital sex is a seeking of gratification outside of a permanent, committed relationship that typically attempts to disrupt the end of sexual intercourse through some means of contraception. Even if contraception (to include withdrawal) is not used, the committed, permanent relationship needed to raise a child would not be present. "...fornication threatens to bring children into the world outside of the marital context they need for their well-being." One can quickly see that this type of sexual union is devoid of real union, because it seeks gratification without commitment. "[M]asturbation and pornography are also contrary to this inherently other-directed unitive drive insofar as they turn it inward toward a fantasy world rather than outward toward another human being."


