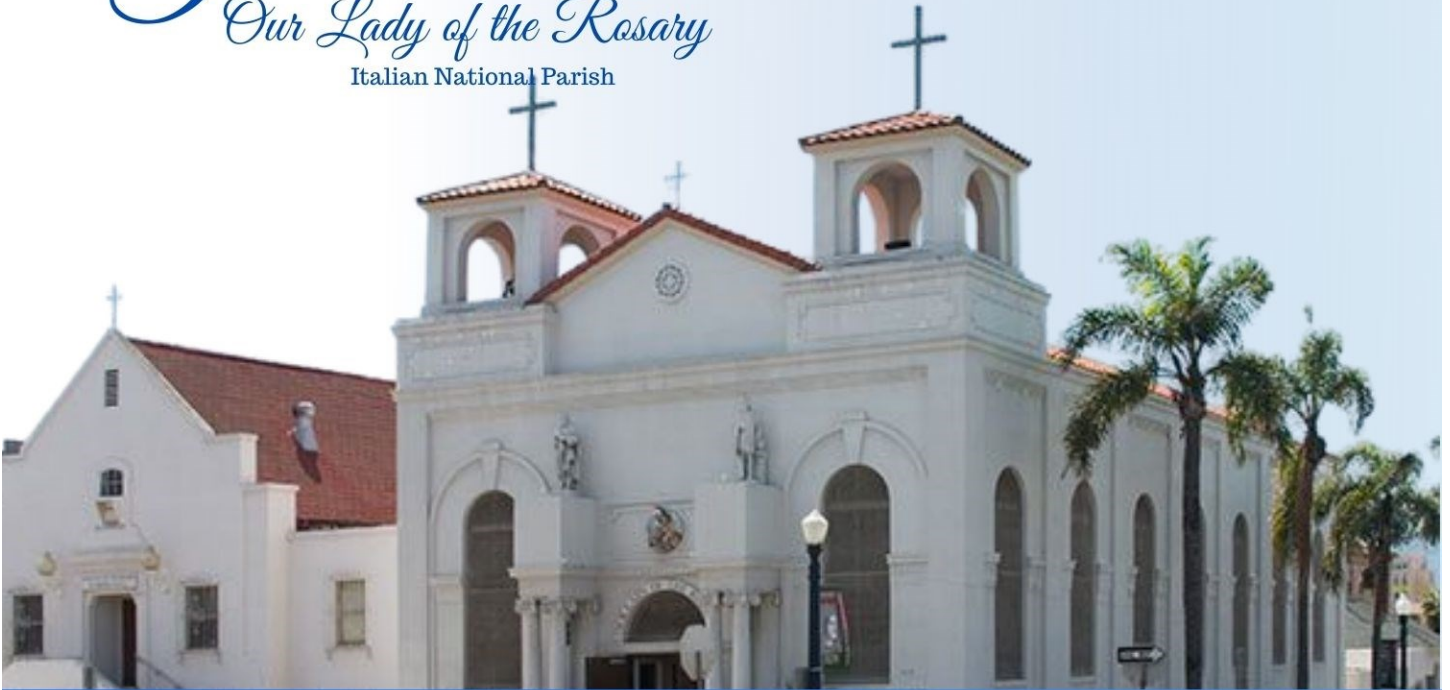

Our Lady of the Rosary

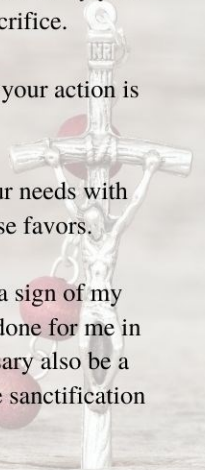

FEAST OF FAITH - The Sign of Peace

"Greet one another with a holy kiss," wrote Saint Paul to the Corinthians (1 Corinthians 16:20), and he said the same thing to other communities as well. The holy kiss, the sign of peace, has been a hallmark of Christians from the very beginning. In giving and receiving the sign of peace, we are not giving something of our own, but something that Christ has given to us. "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you," Jesus told his disciples (John 14:27). Jesus comes to us when we gather together in community. We celebrate the Eucharist not just to receive spiritual nourishment to help us on our solitary way to salvation, but to be transformed into one body, the Body of Christ in the world. As we receive the Eucharist, we are not only united to Christ; we are united to each other. It is never easy to live in community, and we hurt each other on the way. So we need to turn to each other in a sign of reconciliation and forgiveness, to look into each other's eyes, and give and receive the peace that is not ours, but Christ's.

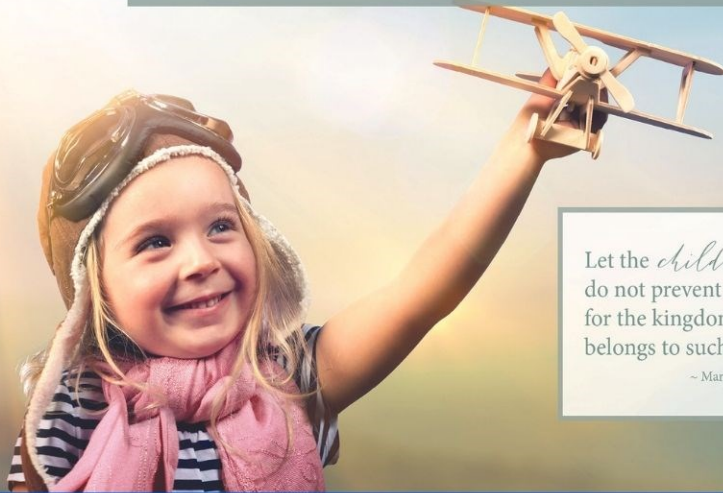

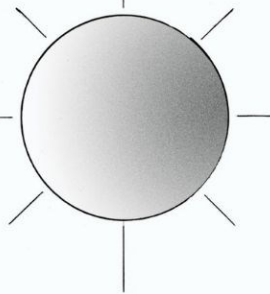


CANTICLE OF THE CREATURES

Do you have brothers and sisters?
Did you ever think of the sun and moon as your brother or sister?

On October 4 we celebrate the feast of St. Francis.
Francis loved all of creation and was grateful for all the
wonderful things God created for us. He taught everyone
to appreciate and be thankful for all of God's gifts.

He wrote a song of gratitude and praise called
"Canticle of the Creatures," naming many parts of creation
and describing how they praise God just by being what they
were created to be.



He sang of "Brother Sun" and "Sisters Moon and Stars."
He called wind and air his brothers and water his sister.
"Brother Fire" was praised for his light and power.
"Sister Earth" was thanked for feeding us with her bounty
and giving us the beauty of flowers.
He even honored "Sister Death."
Francis's canticle reminds us that all creation
gives praise to God. So should we!

Think of some other parts of
God's wonderful creation
not named by Francis.
Make a list and describe them as
"Brother" or "Sister," for example,
"Brother Fox" and "Sister Cloud."
Draw a picture for each example.
Try to come up with one picture each day.
Collect them into a booklet and use them as part of
your prayer before you go to sleep each night.



This could become a very large book!
You could add a picture every day of the year
and never run out of reasons to praise and thank God.
