FEAST OF FAITH - The Sound of Communion

The rites following the reception of Communion are very short. It is as if the Church is saying to us that the only way to respond to this great gift is to go forth and live it! But there are some significant rites yet before we are sent forth from the Mass. After Communion, we pray together in silence or sing a hymn; both are ways to thank God for the gift of the Son. Then the priest prays another collect, the Prayer after Communion. This prayer, usually very short, gathers our prayers into one. It reminds us of what we have already experienced: in receiving the Eucharist, we have received a foretaste of the heavenly banquet; we have eaten the bread of angels. This reality, this knowledge, should transform us, so that we may journey through this life with our hearts set on eternal life, and find in the Eucharist—which is food from heaven and daily bread—the strength and hope we need to work toward God's kingdom of justice here and now. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. IN GRATITUDE FOR CATECHISTS

This week is a good time to thank a catechist. If you are part of a religious education program you can thank St. Charles Borromeo, whose memorial we celebrate this week. Born in 1538 in his family's castle in Italy, St. Charles was the nephew of Pope Pius IV, who appointed him cardinal archbishop of Milan.

At that time, almost no opportunities for religious education existed except for priests. Charles believed that it was important that everyone, especially children, learn about and understand their faith. But this work needed knowledgeable teachers, so he founded the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, often referred to as CCD, to train them. (A confraternity is a group of people who work together toward a common purpose, usually religious or charitable.) These new teachers were called catechists. Their purpose was to instruct, or catechize, others in the ways of faith. Before long he had trained enough catechists to provide religious education for forty thousand students.

Charles Borromeo died in 1584 at the age of 46. He is honored as the patron saint of catechists and catechumens (people who are preparing to be baptized).

How many catechists serve your parish? Think of one special religion teacher who taught you in your parish or Catholic school religious education sessions. What was the most important thing you learned from that teacher? What qualities of that teacher were an example for you of how to be a good Catholic Christian?
