

Mosaic Floor Medallions Part 1

Have you noticed the wood circles in the center isle of the church?



The Baptism of Jesus in the river Jordan.
(Matthew 3:13-17)

Meditation

Jesus appeared in the Jordan and insisted John the Baptist baptize Him. As this occurs, the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in the form of a dove while the Father proclaimed, "This is my beloved Son."

There are four mysteries of the rosary, Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and Luminous. The stained glass windows of Our Lady of the Rosary depict the first three mysteries. On October 16, 2002 was the beginning of the twenty-fifth year of the pontificate of Pope John Paul II. He published an apostolic letter entitled Rosarium Virginis Mariae, which means "On the Rosary of the Virgin Mary." In chapter II, he described the various "mysteries" of the rosary. However, instead of 15 mysteries, the Holy Father suddenly wrote

about 20. He called these five additional events the "Mysteries of Light," also known as the "Luminous Mysteries." Pope John Paul II could see that a part of the story of the life of Christ was missing from the Holy Rosary. What was missing in the rosary meditations was the start of Christ's mission to proclaim the Kingdom of God and the lead up to His death, most noticeably lacking in the meditation of the rosary was the mention of the Holy Eucharist or The Last Supper. He declared the Mysteries of light to be The Baptism of Jesus in the river Jordan, Wedding at Cana, Proclamation of the Kingdom of God, The Transfiguration, and The Institution of the Holy Eucharist.

Fr. Joe decided to complete the Mysteries of the Rosary at Our Lady of the Rosary with The Luminous Mysteries to be depicted in the center isle of the church. In late 2019, Fr Joe commissioned Carole Oueijan to create the four mosaic tiled medallions to depict the Luminous Mysteries for the church.



In early June Fr. Joe went on a day trip to the artists workshop located in Hacienda Heights to see the first two completed medallions.

Feast of Faith - Little Mysteries

Two small rites—or, as one liturgist has called them, "little mysteries"—accompany the preparation of the gifts. The priest or deacon takes a small cruet of water from the server and adds a drop of water to the wine. Then, after the elevation of the chalice (and the incensation, if incense is used), the priest washes his hands. Both of these actions were at first practical, matter-of-fact realities: in the ancient world the wine was usually quite thick, and was generally mixed with water before it was drunk. And in the early church, when the faithful brought forward a great variety of gifts at this time, there was a definite need for the presider to wash his hands!

But now these rites serve a purely symbolic function. The mingling of the water and wine is accompanied by a prayer that speaks of the wonderful exchange of the Mass, the mingling of Christ's divinity and our humanity. And as the priest washes his hands, he prays words of supplication from Psalm 51, acknowledging his own sinfulness in the presence of the assembly before he dares to approach the altar for this most sacred action.







