

(Hail Holy Queen)


Hail Holy Queen,

in this valley of tears.





# Fifth Sunday of Easter

#### **Gospel Summary**

While Jesus was with his disciples at the Last Supper, he pointed toward his future glory following his death and resurrection where he would be reunited with his Father in heaven. He also gave the disciples a command: to love one another. But the disciples didn't have to figure out how to do this on their own. Jesus told them to love one another in the same way he had loved them.

#### **Reflection for Families**

Jesus wanted the disciples to love one another and all followers with a binding love. It is this same kind of love that binds families together. When other people turn their backs and walk away, it is symbolic of Jesus' love that families are bound by a love incomparable anywhere else in our own experience. We fail at times, but rarely in any other setting do we see anything close to the unconditional love God has for us, as we see in the love parents show their children


#### **Bringing the Gospel Into Your Family**

Find someone in your neighborhood, school, place of work, or within your family who sometimes feels left out. Reach out to that person with the kind of love Jesus describes in this Gospel. Make them feel welcome and know they are a child of God. Perhaps you will send them a greeting card, say a special prayer for them, visit them, or invite them to your home. When your action is complete, share with one another where you saw Jesus in the experience you had with the person.

#### All Things New

The new heaven and new earth described by Revelation is where God will dwell fully among God's beloved creation. God's reign will be a reign of love, where death will be no more. 



# QUEEN OF HEAVEN, REJOICE

May is the month dedicated to the Blessed Mother. One beautiful way to pray to her is the rosary. Another prayer we associate with Mary is the Angelus. *Angelus* is the Latin word for "angel," from the opening words of the prayer: "The angel spoke. . . ."


In the sixteenth century, church bells in many towns would ring at 6:00 a.m., noon, and 6:00 p.m.

The bells called people to pause in their work and say the Angelus. Many people continue this practice today. Does your parish church ring bells at the Angelus times?

During the Easter season the Angelus is replaced by the Regina Caeli, Latin for "Queen of Heaven." It reminds us of Mary's participation in Christ's saving work of redemption. The prayer is very simple. Perhaps you can choose a time to pray it as a family each day this week. Consider praying it throughout the Easter season.

When prayed in a group, the lines of the prayer alternate between a leader (L) and the group who recite the responses (R).

The closing prayer is recited together.



Let us pray. God of life,

- L. Queen of heaven, rejoice, alleluia
- R. For Christ, your Son and Son of God,
- L. has risen as he said, alleluia.
- R. Pray to God for us, alleluia.
- L. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia,
- R. For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia
