Since the covid lockdown in 2020 there have been several large hurdles for the program with the current structure and curriculum. The structure and curriculum was designed for strictly face-to-face teaching and learning. The lockdown forced volunteer teachers into unfamiliar territory with online teaching.

In Fall of 2021 parents were eager to have their kids in a classroom setting. Slowly the children began to return to the CCD program. Just when the children were due to return from Christmas break there was a surge in covid illnesses, classes were postponed. This left us struggling to get the weekly content and lessons to the children to ensure they stayed on track.

The end of last CCD school year the director and a few teachers set out to look into new curriculum. They had four primary objectives.

- Increase children engagement and participation in the classroom
- Provide teachers with better resources for teaching
- Create hybrid ability for in class and homeschool teaching
- Encourage parent participation and faith formation

After several months of reviewing materials Finding God by Loyola Press was chosen. Finding God offers parents and families materials specifically designed for use at home whether catechesis takes place in the parish, school, or home. From at-home, family-friendly lesson plans, to interactive study guides, to the exciting online game Fishers of Faith and the other activities will refresh the parents own faith while helping become an active partner in their children's faith formation.

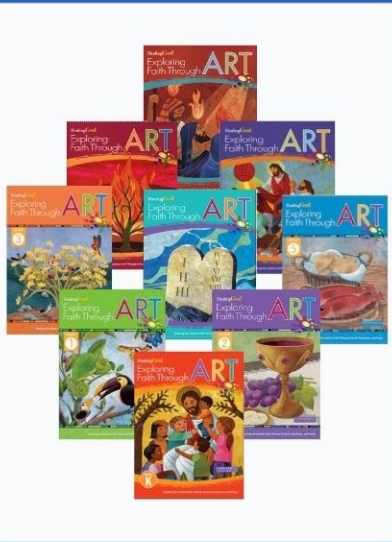

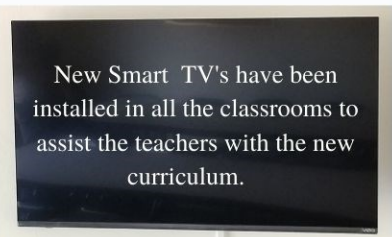

### Gospel Summary

In an attempt to show the people that God will forgive and accept sinners into the Kingdom, Jesus told three parables about being lost and then found. The first parable was about a shepherd who had one hundred sheep but lost one. The shepherd searched until he found the lost lamb. There was much celebration on the part of the shepherd and his neighbors because something lost was found. The second parable concerned a widow who searched her house until she found a lost piece of silver. Finally, Jesus told the parable of the prodigal son who squandered his share of his inheritance and went home to beg his father to let him be a worker. Instead the father was so thrilled to see this son who had been lost to him that he threw a big party. All three of these parables illustrate the joy that will be in heaven when one lost sinner is found.

### Reflection for Families

If you have ever lost a child either at a shopping mall, amusement park, or outside playing, you know the anguish of losing something beyond measure. The joy you experienced when you found each other is often something you can't even put into words. Part of you wants to be angry because the child caused you so much grief, but mostly you are just so happy to see the child, you can hardly speak. If we've had experiences like this, then we have an indication about how God feels when we are truly sorry for our sins and want to be part of God's family.

### Bringing the Gospel Into Your Family

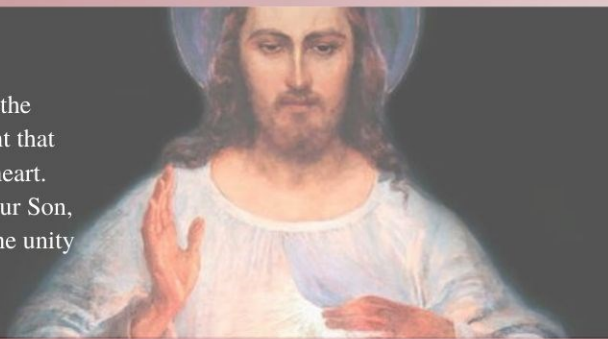
What is an irreplaceable or valuable item that belongs to your family? Perhaps you have an item that belonged to someone who has died, or something that has been passed down through the generations. Try to trace the item's history through your family and then make a connection to it and today's Gospel. What would happen if you lost the item, or it turned up missing? How hard would you look for it? How would you feel when you found it? Finally, consider how your experience might help illustrate the joy Jesus described in this Gospel when one sinner repents.

### Relying on God's Love

Imagine being among those who heard Jesus address the Pharisees and scribes in the encounter we hear in today's Gospel: "What man among you having a hundred sheep and losing one of them would not leave the ninety-nine in the desert and go after the lost one until he finds it?" Would you leave ninety-nine in the desert in order to find one lost sheep? In the parable, Jesus is showing us the depths of God's love, the illogical, incredible love God has for each of us. Moses counted on this loving mercy as he spoke for the wandering people; Saint Paul acknowledges his reliance on it in his letter to Timothy. God desires to draw you close, seeking you when you are lost. Are you ready to be drawn into God's loving embrace?

## PIERCED WITH SORROW

Thursday was the feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Bible does not record the day of Mary's birth and it contains very little information about her life. What we do know we learn in connection with the life of her Son, Jesus. When Mary and Joseph presented their child to God in the temple, the prophet Simeon told Mary that a sword—that is, sorrow—would pierce her heart (Luke 2:35). Mary must have remembered that prophecy as she stood at the foot of the cross when Jesus was dying.

Mary knew the great sorrow of seeing her son die, so she is the perfect companion for all those who grieve. We can look to her for comfort, especially this week as we remember the lives that were lost on September 11, 2001. Many mothers lost children and wives lost husbands. Many people lost their mothers. Each year since then people around the country and around the world have paused to remember this great loss. Family members gather together to comfort and support one another. The whole country pauses for a moment to pray for all the people who lost someone on that day.

Today, September 11, take a moment to pray this traditional prayer, the Act of Love. It reminds us that we should love God and love and forgive others. It is good to think about these things on this sad day in our country.

When you pray, ask Mary to console those whose hearts are pierced with sorrow, who grieve today.

*O my God, I love you above all things,  
with my whole heart and soul,  
because you are all good and worthy of all love.  
I love my neighbor as myself for the love of you.  
I forgive all who have injured me,  
and I ask pardon of all whom I have injured.*

V. The Angel of the Lord declared to Mary:  
R. And she conceived the power of the Holy Spirit.  
Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.  
V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord:  
R. Be it done unto me according to Thy word.  
Hail Mary...  
V. And the Word was made Flesh: (Kneel)
