Our Lady of the Rosary Mission Statement

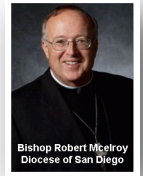

Dear Parishioners:

Praised be Jesus and Mary!

Many of you know that over the past several months we have been talking about considering possible upgrades and maintenance inside the church. Ideas, too numerous to list here, have been discussed. Recently I engaged by written agreement, the services of Conrad Schmitt Studios Inc., to do some initial investigative study of historical paint analysis, condition of art, etc., before any final decisions are made going forward.

In late May you will see some scaffolding set-up inside the church for the purpose of conducting these various studies. I estimate that the equipment will be in place for approximately three weeks or so. Therefore, I thank you in advance for your patience during this test process.

Also, you have probably heard that the Italian Cultural Center (ICC) tenant, formerly located on our corner property at 1669 Columbia and Date Street, has recently moved their functions into the parish office building. This is the first step and beginning of a plan to clean up the interior of the corner building, make repairs, and to potentially move Our Lady's Gift Shop business there at some point in time, pending design plans and communication with the project contractor and the City of San Diego.

These are both exciting projects to consider and we will keep you informed as progress unveils.

Please, Come to Church Dressed Appropriately!

To be modestly and tastefully dressed is a sign of respect for God, for our selves, and for others. It's a false assumption that God does not care how we dress. Jesus told us, "Whatever you do to the least of my brothers, you do it to me." If our attire is indecently provocative (short shorts, strapless, backless, spaghetti strap dresses/tops, or displaying cleavage), displaying unwholesome graphics (skulls, advertisements, scantily clad people) or tattered, it becomes offensive to our brothers and sisters who are worshipping the Lord and therefore offensive to God's Majesty. Ask this question: "Would you dress this way before God?" You are! He sees everything and you are in His house.
