

How the Madonna del Lume Devotion Began

The Madonna del Lume Society in San Diego was established in 1937 by the families of Sicilian fisherman who originated from the fishing village of Porticello, Sicily. The Feast of the Madonna del Lume shares, quite visibly with our community, a tradition and a profound story of faith and hope. It is a story of the powerful intercession of the Madonna on behalf of a group of Sicilian fishermen who, tormented and thrown off course by torrential storms at sea, faced the reality that they would perish. These experienced seafaring men were frightened, unsure, and desperate for guidance and safety to return to shore to embrace their families and community once more. It was in these moments of darkness and fear, when they humbled themselves in complete trust and devotion to God, that their prayers were answered.

The men told of a glowing light that appeared, illuminating the dark sky above. Just as the wise men once followed the guiding star over Bethlehem to visit the newborn savior over 2,000 years ago, these Sicilian fishermen faithfully followed the glowing light that guided them to port. Once safely home, they continued to follow the mysterious light to a grotto near Porticello.

Exploring the sea cave, they found a slab of marble bearing an image of the Madonna. They carried it into town, but twice it mysteriously returned to the grotto. The community decided to leave the image of the Madonna at the grotto and build a church on the spot to protect it. Sicilians fervently believe that the lives of hundreds of fishermen have been saved by the intervention of our Blessed Maria Santissima del Lume, Our Most Holy Mother of Light, the guardian and patroness of fishermen.



This beautiful religious and cultural celebration of Sicilian Catholic heritage for the past 85 years has been passed on to our members through their families, and years of community collaboration to keep this special tradition alive and vibrant in San Diego. Members have learned from a young age about the purity, grace and strength of our Most Holy Mother as our protective, loving and most powerful ambassador of Christ in the midst of a challenging and often chaotic world. As a dedicated and loving mother, La Madonna reminds us that she is a powerful intercessor on our behalf. She comforts each of us with the light of faith, hope and love through all of our challenges and afflictions.

Celebration in Poticello, Sicily



Today, Porticello, Sicily, celebrates the Festa della Madonna del Lume the full first week of October. The entire municipality participates in the procession with fireworks and veneration of La Madonna at the original church of Madonna del Lume. On the Monday of the feast, the sacred painting of the Madonna is taken down from the altar and processed through the town to its port. Devotees pack the sanctuary hoping for an opportunity

to touch the painting on its way to the street in order to receive its healing and protective powers. It's a moving moment to experience.

Gospel Summary

Like a relentless child, the widow in Jesus' parable wouldn't give up. She continually begged the judge for justice against her opponents. Not because the judge wanted to see justice done, but because he grew tired of the woman's pleading, he granted her request. The point Jesus wanted to make with this story is how much our loving God will answer our prayers if we persist in our asking.

Reflection for Families

What happens when our children pester us long enough for something? If it's not life threatening and they've bugged us long enough, we usually find a way of giving in without losing face. We know just how the judge in Luke's Gospel felt! Let the story of the persistent widow strengthen your prayers. Even if they are not answered in just the way we ask, God hears our prayers and cares for us.

Bringing the Gospel Into Your Family

Carey Landry and Carol Jean Kinghorn offer us a lively song thanking God for making us who we are. Most Christian book stores or religious educators have a copy of "Hi God 2" where you can find the song, "If I Were a Butterfly." Try making up lively hand motions or dance steps to this song as you teach your child the words and movements. Tell your children what things you are grateful for.
