RESERVATIONS & DEPOSIT: A deposit of \$500 (check/ money order) per person is required at time of booking payable by check or Money Order to Polyways Travel Service LLC, with the completed booking form. Full payment is due by September 13th, 2019.

TOUR COST: Total cost of the tour is \$ 3,599 per person based on double occupancy, based on tariffs and currency exchange levels in effect 02/01/2019 and subject to adjustment in the event of significant changes in the exchange rate. Tour based on a minimum of 20 passengers.

CANCELLATION: Once a deposit or full payment is received, cancellations will only be accepted in writing (mail or e-mail). The following cancellation terms and fees will be applied based on the date that the written cancellation is received by the pilgrimage coordinator. Prior to 09/13/2019, full refund of the ground portion minus \$100 penalty for cancellation. No refund given after 09/13/2019. No exceptions.

TOUR ARRANGEMENTS: Air transportation will be provided in economy class from San Diego Airport and returning to San Diego. Overnight accommodations will be provided in twin bedded rooms. Single room supplement \$500. Unused accommodation and features of this tour are not refundable, nor exchangeable for other services. The rights is reserved to substitute hotels and sight seeing features if it becomes necessary.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Overnight accommodations will be provided in standard rate hotels or pilgrim/religious house in twin bedded rooms unless double bed is specifically requested and available. When possible, roommates will be assigned. We reserve the right to substitute hotels and sightseeing features.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOUR COST: Items of a personal nature, phone calls, laundry, optional tour insurance, Mass collections, services and additional meals or beverages other than those specifically mentioned in this brochure.



Marian Shrines of Europe Nov 4-15, 2019

Nov 4 – Departure

Depart San Diego Airport for your transatlantic flight to Lisbon. Meals will be served on board.

Nov 5– Arrival

Upon arrival at Lisbon Airport meet your guide. Orientation tour of Lisbon including Mass at St Anthony Church, if time permitting. Transfer to hotel in Fatima for dinner and overnight. In the evening candlelight rosary procession.

Nov 6 – Fatima

Morning Mass in Cova da Iria, the actual place of the apparition where Our Lady of Fatima gave a message to the world through Jacinta, Francisco and Lucia. Guided tour of the shrine, visit the Fatima Light and Peace Museum. In the afternoon Via Sacra will lead us to the homes of the seers in Aljustrel and pasturage at Valinhos, where an Angel appeared to the children of Fatima. Dinner and overnight. In the evening candlelight rosary procession.

Nov 7– Fatima – Santiago de Compostela

Travel to the medieval city of Santiago de Compostela. According to legend, the bones of the Apostle St. James the Great were transported to Spain after his martyrdom in A.D. 44 and placed at the site of the Cathedral in the year 813. Mass at the Cathedral followed by a guided tour. Dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

Nov 8 – Santiago de Compostela – Avila

Depart for Avila. Mass at Convent of St. Teresa, the birthplace of the great mystic and the first woman to be named a Doctor of the Church. Visit to the Monastery of the Incarnation, a Carmelite convent, where St Teresa remained for 30 years. Dinner and overnight in Avila.

Nov 9 – Avila – Segovia – Madrid

Travel to Segovia. Mass at the tomb of St John of the Cross. Transfer to Madrid, orientational tour of the city on arrival. Dinner and overnight in Madrid.

Marian Shrines of Europe Nov 4-15, 2019

Nov 10 – Madrid – Zaragoza

Morning Mass celebrated at the Almudena Cathedral, Madrid. Afternoon transfer to Zaragoza where St James had a vision of Our Lady standing on the pillar encouraging him to continue his apostolic mission in Spain. Dinner and overnight in Zaragoza.

Nov 11 – Zaragoza

After morning Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar short guided tour of the city. Transfer to Lourdes for dinner and overnight. In the evening candlelight rosary procession.

Nov 12– Lourdes

During your stay in Lourdes we celebrate Mass at the Grotto, we pray for the sick and drink water from the miraculous spring. Submerge yourself at the baths and visit the places connected with St Bernadette. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

Nov 13 – Lourdes – Montserrat

Morning Mass at the Immaculate Conception Basilica. Transfer to Montserrat for dinner and overnight.

Nov 14 – Barcelona

After morning Mass at the Black Madonna Chapel in Montserrat drive to Barcelona for a panoramic tour of the capitol of Catalonia, Spain's most cosmopolitan city. Our main focus is on the famous Sagrada Familia Nativity and Passion Facade- to which Antoni Gaudi dedicated the latter part of his life. Return to Montserrat for dinner and overnight. Nov 15 – Departure
