This parish-based retreat offers the opportunity to renew your spirituality, to strengthen your faith and its application in your daily life, and to build and deepen lasting friendships throughout your parish community.

The retreat begins on Thursday evening, August 1st, with check-in at 6:30 p.m. at Ss. Peter and Paul Church. Transportation will be provided for you to and from the retreat center. The retreat concludes at the 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass at Ss. Peter and Paul Church. A lunch reception will follow.
