## End-Of-Year Pick-up/Return of Materials to School

A list of items that will need to be returned to school for each student will be emailed to you on *May 22*. Please print out this Student Check-in List, or recopy it, so that the items being returned can be checked-off. Please have a separate bag or box for each student in the family, in which you will place the materials being returned. Attach the Student Check-in List to the bag or box. Items are required to sit idle for 72 hours before teachers unpack and check them as returned.

*Monday, June 1*, will be our day to Pick-up/Return of Materials to School. Families pull into the school parking lot, off James St., and park in the first rows of parking spaces closest to the school during your assigned time. Weather permitting, tables will be set outside next to the building, where families will be directed to pick-up and return materials. If the weather does not cooperate, a school staff member will bring your child's materials out to you, and then carry in the returned items. We are requesting that no family members enter the school building.

We will have **one** pick-up/return day with three pick-up/return windows of time:

On *Monday, June 1*:

8:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m. all families with last names beginning with A-F

12:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m. all families with last names beginning with G-Q

3:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m. all families with last names beginning with R-Z

If your assigned time does not work, please call the school office to make other arrangements. Thank you!
