Audience Comments/Eyes & Ears/Correspondence:

Positive comments heard from alum and current student. Alum wishes our school went through 12th grade.

Positive relationships/trust with our teachers; personal relationships.

2nd grade teacher has already reached out to the parents of her incoming students. Miss Ver Hage is an awesome communicator.

Kids are ready to get back to school.

Vacation Bible School – SKDS students attended and had a fun time.

Old Business: None

Pastor's Report: Construction has ramped up. Drainage system should be in place in next couple of days. Parking lot apron, sidewalks, fencing posts in, asphalt and then fence should be in before school starts. Still working on getting changing rooms done before start of school. Painters are arriving next Monday to start setting up in the church. Gym floor is still a big headache; working with our insurance company to sort out who is paying for the repair and at what speed and what extent needs to be done. Will we need to look for somewhere else for volleyball? Possible that a temporary solution for the gym floor will have to be made and then the gym will need to be completely replaced next year.

Administrator's Report: General Update

4th Grade teacher hired – Leann Anderson. Currently working at the YMCA; also has experience in speech pathology.

3k/4k aides: offer has been made to two different people.

School Social Worker: number of people have applied; Catholic Charities has phone interviewed 3 candidates and 2 interviews have been set up.

School calendar has been posted on the website and will be in the family folders. Thanksgiving: no school Wednesday and Friday. We will not have a day off for conferences in November. Conferences will be held at night on both Thursday and Friday.

Updates/new policies to the Parish and School Policy Manual:

- rights and responsibilities of parents
- criminal records
- confidential information
- electronic resources and communications (previously students could use phones but will no longer be able to; staff/faculty will have to sign a form saying they agree to this and SKDS has authorized them to use their personal phones)
- service animals.
- Significant Changes: physical examination of personnel, compulsory school attendance, standards-based curriculum, instruction, and assessment.

Allison Seufzer/SCRIP: SCRIP does need more help. Concern with the number of school families that purchase SCRIP and that help out on the weekends. Ms. Crombie presented an idea to Finance Committee - % of SCRIP purchased put towards next year's tuition. This is done at other Arch schools.

New ad placed in Inspire magazine; using a tactic different from what has been used in the past.

Radio station/Jennifer Warmboldt: many ideas given to Ms. Crombie on different advertising options.

Field Trips: policy has been tweaked in regard to chaperones taking pictures. One of the changes is that pictures cannot be posted during the field trip.

Sandra David, Director of Teaching and Learning at BDUSD: Title I, II, III, IDEA funds. Downside is that travel time has to be counted. Ms. Crombie re-applied; professional development and resources to work with students and teachers.
