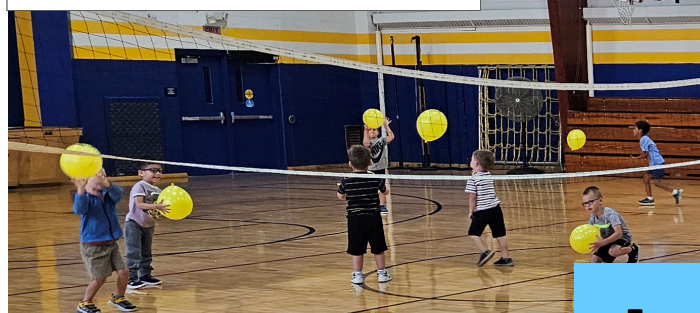

## PHILOSOPHY

Saint Katharine Drexel School offers a 4K program for all children.

Each child is a unique and cherished individual, possessing individual gifts and talents. At Saint Katharine Drexel School we are thankful for each child and strive to instill in each one that s/he is special. We encourage the full development of each individual physically, mentally, emotionally, socially, and morally with the help of his/her parents, who are a child's primary teachers.

## GOALS

Our goals are to help the child:

1. Develop positive self-concepts through increased awareness of his/her own characteristics and abilities;
2. Develop positive concepts about family, friends, community, and school;
3. Learn about loving and caring and discovering and appreciating the world around him/her;
4. Increase his/her awareness and appreciation of the five primary senses;
5. Develop attitudes of sharing, taking turns, helping, listening, thanking, and celebrating; and
6. Progress in his/her development in the areas of Fine Motor, Gross Motor, Language, Social, and Cognitive Skills.



## 4K PROGRAM

The 4K program is for children who are four years old by September 1 of the year enrolled.

Our 4K program is based on the series called "I Am Special". The "I Am Special" program is designed to:

1. Help the young child discover his/her special qualities and
2. Realize his/her importance in our world.

The primary focus of the program is one of helping the child develop positive self-concepts through awareness and that each one is specially formed. These positive self-concepts are the foundation for developing the attitudes of loving, sharing, and helping. A positive self-image helps the child begin to develop positive relationships with others.



Saint Katharine Drexel School offers a wonderful Extend-A-Day (EAD) Childcare Program at the cost of \$15.00 per day. The EAD Childcare Program runs from 11:00AM- 3:15PM. Your child may attend opposite his/her 4K schedule.

School lunch will be offered to your child for the fees set at the onset of the school year or s/he may bring a cold lunch from home.

Saint Katharine Drexel School has a Before (BSC) and After School Care (ASC) Program. It is open to students 3K through Grade 8. BSC runs from 6:45-7:45AM, and ASC runs from 3:15 – 6:00PM., Monday—Friday on school days. Our fees are competitively priced. For more information go to
