

#### **DIRECTOR OF YOUTH MINISTRY JOB DESCRIPTION**

STATUS: Part-time

### **General Description:**

To build young disciples of Christ by developing and implementing a comprehensive approach to youth ministry. The Youth Minister will serve as a spiritual leader by focusing on worship, discipleship, team building, mission and outreach. The Youth Minister provides vision and coordination for the parish's efforts in ministry to youth in 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Help plan, develop and implement all aspects of a balanced youth ministry.
- Create a core leadership team of youth and adult volunteers.
- Recruit and train volunteers who work with youth and ensure adequate support.
- Be a liaison between the church and community organizations that relate to youth and youth ministry.
- Create programming for the youth group with the Faith Formation Coordinator.
- Work in partnership with the Pastor, Parish Council and Faith Formation Coordinator to effectively reach youth in the parish and develop a vibrant youth ministry outreach plan.
- Keep records of youth participation and manage the youth ministry budget.
- Communicate in a timely manner using all available resources including: email, website, bulletin and weekly newsletter. Ensure communication with church staff, leadership, parents and the parish.
- Foster the involvement of youth in the life of the parish including service in various ministries and committees.
- Ensure that the Save Environment policies are observed and implemented.
- Be a presence in the parish community through its liturgical and social activities.

## **Organizational Relationship:**

The Youth Minister reports to the Pastor and works closely with the Faith Formation Coordinator.

# **Qualifications and Aptitudes:**

- Must embrace Christian discipline and Roman Catholic doctrine and theology.
- Education: Bachelor's Degree. A degree in Education, Theology, or related field is preferred.
- Must have demonstrated ability to plan, develop, coordinate and implement a youth ministry.
- Must have excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Proficient in using the computer including: Word, email, social media etc.
- Must be committed to the Roman Catholic faith and an active, practicing member.
