## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity



Brothers and sisters, today the universal Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, the central mystery of our faith. We gather as the people of God, called by the love of the Father, in the grace of Jesus Christ, and in the communion of the Holy Spirit.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is "the central mystery of faith and Christian life." It is described as "the mystery of God in Himself" and "the source of all other mysteries of faith; it is the light that illuminates them." The entire history of salvation is presented as the revelation of the one true God —Father, Son, and Holy Spirit— who separates us from sin to reconcile and unite us with Him.

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, celebrated on the Sunday following Pentecost, marks the culmination of God's revelation in the history of salvation. This placement in the liturgical calendar is not coincidental; it signifies the moment when, after the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, the complete understanding of God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is revealed and entrusted to the Church for its mission. This liturgical positioning emphasizes that the trinitarian mystery is not an abstract doctrine, but the very dynamic of God's saving action in the world.

The Eucharist is the Source and Summit of our Catholic Faith. Every year on the Second Sunday after Pentecost we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (formerly known as Corpus Christi). This Solemnity commemorates the institution of the Eucharist which Christ gave us at the Last Supper and gives us



at every Mass through the Consecration of the Bread and Wine into His Body and Blood in Holy Communion.
