FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters

The holy Gospel this weekend presents us Jesus sending his disciples on a mission. On this occasion, the Lord appointed seventy-two disciples to go ahead of him, two by two, to every city and prepare his arrival (cf. Lk 10:1-2.)

As the disciples went to the places where Jesus intended to visit, they encountered many difficulties and obstacles. Today we are called by Jesus to also Preach the Gospel all over the world, knowing that preaching Jesus' love can sometimes cause us to be discouraged because we are not exempt from the difficulties the disciples had to face. Difficulties like: misunderstandings, great efforts that seem fruitless, lack of resources, etc. But even in these moments we can consider ourselves as instruments. The most important thing is not what we can do ourselves, but what Jesus, who works through each one of us can accomplish.

Upon returning from the mission, the disciples discover that they themselves need to continue Jesus' mission in the world. Thus, in addition to securing the happiest possible life on earth, they feel the pride of preparing to attain eternal happiness. "Do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you – the Lord tells them –; rather rejoice that your names are written in heaven" (Lk 10:20.)

Today, Christ is sending each one of us to proclaim the Good news, so that many people may welcome the message of the Gospel and accept the Salvation He gave us on the cross.

I want to take this opportunity to thank Wilma McNamara who has served the Parish as the daily sacristan for many years. We are so blessed by her presence and help. Thank you, Wilma. May God bless you always.


