Fifteenth week in ordinary time

Dear brothers and sisters, today I want to call your attention to an event that happened last Saturday July 5 in Italy, were *Father Matteo Balzano*, a priest of the diocese of Novara (Italy) was found dead in the rectory. He was 35 years old. He had taken his own life.

The death of a priest, especially when it involves an extreme and silent decision like suicide, forces us to stop, because behind the collar, behind the altar, behind the patient smile and constant availability, there is a man... and we often forget that.

Those who love the Church today must also learn to love its pastors. Not idealizing them, but truly being close to them. With kindness, with respect, with the same mercy we expect from them. They also need to be saved from time to time.

I share this to you, not to complain, but rather to make you think about how you treat your priests, as the Gospel today reminds us to be good Samaritans, this call is not only for religious people, this is for all of us, who follow Jesus, you can be that good Samaritan to your priest, in so many ways, be the one who helps him in prayer.

As I reflect on this, I feel blessed, because I know your love and prayers for me, your support and presence make me feel the presence of God who always comes to my help as the good Samaritan who cares, loves and protects.

May the Lord Bless all of you and please do not forget to pray for me.


