FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Nineteenth Sunday in the ordinary time

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The readings of this Sunday invite us to always be vigilant, waiting for the arrival of the Lord. In the first reading, the Book of Wisdom reminds us of the first night of Passover in Egypt when the Israelites were freed from slavery and called to be the people of God. The Lord asked them to wait for his passage "with good cheer," offering sacrifices, awake and standing (cf. Wis 18:6-9). Then, year after year, the people celebrated Passover as a memory of salvation, with this same expectant and attentive attitude: God passes near us once again. In the letter to the Hebrews, the sacred author sings the greatness of the faith of the ancient patriarchs; "By faith, Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place he was to receive as an inheritance, and he went out, not knowing where he was going for he was looking forward to the city that has foundations, whose designer and builder is God" (Heb 11:8,10).

By faith, we know that Christ walks beside us and calls us. In every moment, He awaits a generous response from us. By discovering the presence of the Lord in everyday circumstances, we learn "to live each moment with a vibration of eternity". With this inner attitude, everything we do, whether small or great, important or not, can be a path that leads us to God. And also, if we are aware of having received much, we will act with a sense of responsibility, because we know that "to whom much has been given, much will be required, and to whom much has been entrusted, much will be demanded" (Lk 12:48). In this struggle, we count on the help of the Virgin Mary. She always listens to us, she is always close to us; and, being the Mother of the Son, she shares in the power of the Son, in his goodness. We can always place our entire life in the hands of this Mother, who is always close to each one of us.


