

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Solemnity of All Saints and Feast of All Souls

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This weekend the church celebrates the holiness of God in all His saints. Also we remember all our brothers and sisters who have gone before us and sleep in Christ.

First, on Saturday November 1, we celebrate the solemnity of all the countless saints. Therefore, it is an appropriate day to reflect that all Christians are called to holiness and happiness. Holiness is living according to the plan that Jesus left us in the gospel. It is embodying Jesus Himself in our lives. It is following Him. It is living life in all circumstances according to His words. For this reason, there is a close relationship between 'being holy' and 'following Jesus'; between 'living the life of God' and 'being Blessed.' In celebrating the saints, what we are really celebrating is God, who has worked wonders in the hearts and actions of limited human beings.

Second, on Sunday November 2, we remember all our departed brothers and sisters. This commemoration reminds us that death is a natural part of the cycle of life, a reminder that every moment is precious. Although the loss of a loved one is a sad event, it also teaches us to appreciate the beauty and fragility of life.

The departure of a loved one leaves a space that is never completely filled, but it also leaves us a legacy of love and memories that endure. Every shared story, every lesson taught, and every joyful moment becomes a permanent part of who we are. In the pain of loss, we also find the celebration of a love that transcends the barrier of death.

The lives of those who have passed continue in us, in the lessons they left us and, in the marks they made on our hearts. Their memory is a treasure we carry with us, a source of strength and hope. In every memory, we relive the love and keep their memory alive, an eternal tribute to their passage through our lives.

And knowing that the hope of eternal life is fundamental in the Christian faith. The resurrection of the dead assures us that death does not have the final word, but that those who believe in Jesus will have eternal life in communion with God.

Let us pray for all the souls in purgatory, may the resurrected Lord be the hope that one day we will see them again in the peace of God.

"May all the souls of the faithful departed, by the mercy of God rest in peace," Amen.


