

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Fourth Week of Advent Love

Dear brothers and sisters,

In this final week of Advent, known as the week of love, the heart fills with a serene yet intense waiting. Mary, a young woman from Nazareth, teaches us to open ourselves without reservation to God's action. Her humble and trusting "yes" allowed the eternal promise to become flesh.

As the prophet Isaiah had said, *"Lord himself will give you a sign, the virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel"* (Isaiah 7:14.) We see in Mary a humble woman in which God fulfilled his promise and transformed her into the Mother of God. This is how God acts also in us. A seemingly small response, full of faith, can transform our daily lives into a great divine work. Think about the simplest moments of our day-to-day lives, we can say yes to God who is coming, in a chance encounter with a friend, in the sometimes-monotonous passing of the hours of work, or in a pleasant family evening.

So, as we contemplate the Child of Bethlehem, how can we not be certain of God's love for us and his loving care? In all the events that make up our lives, we can be sure that God speaks to us and saves us.

"Shower down, O heavens, from above, and let the clouds pour down righteousness; let the earth open, and let salvation spring forth" (Isaiah 45:8). The entrance antiphon for this Fourth Sunday of Advent expresses our need for a God who saves us. On many occasions, our prayer will consist of expressing from the depths of our hearts this longing for God. Whether we are aware of our limitations and feel the pain of our wounds, or when we experience joy in small details, we want everything to be permeated by God's love. We realize that a life with him is radically different from an existence confined to ourselves.

Knowing that the Almighty God, chose to reveal his face in the tender figure of a child. I would like to invite you during these days, as we long to approach Bethlehem let us approach it with two complementary feelings: 1. reverence before the mystery and 2. the affection that welcomes it into the warmth of a home.

Remember that God comes close in a way that surpasses all logic, not with power and noise, but in the fragility of a child. This mystery invites us to examine our own readiness; are we prepared to receive Him in the simplicity of our daily lives?

Remember,

"God loves you, God loves me, God loves us"
