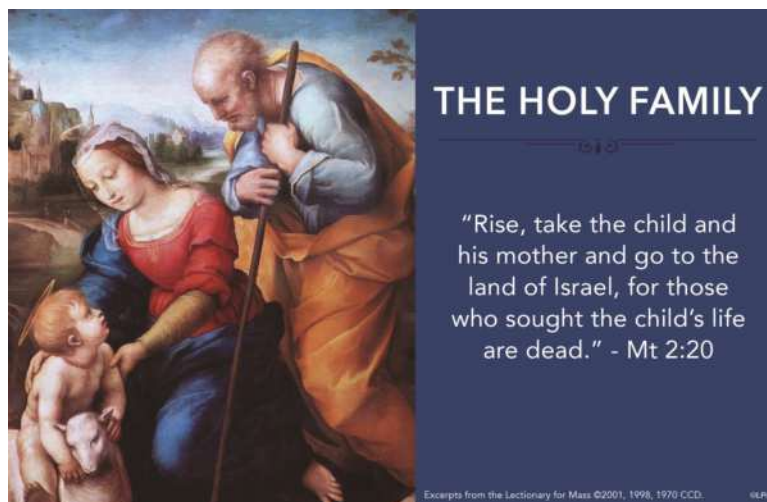

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Feast of the Holy Family

Dear brothers and sisters,

On this first Sunday after Christmas, while we are still immersed in the joyful atmosphere of the feast, the Church invites us to contemplate the Holy Family of Nazareth, and asks us to reflect on the message that comes from the Holy Family, because it is above all a message of faith.

In the family life of Mary and Joseph, God is truly at the center, and He is present in the person of Jesus. This is why the family of Nazareth is holy, because it is centered on Jesus. When parents and children breathe together this atmosphere of faith, they possess an energy that allows them to face even difficult trials, as the experience of the Holy Family shows, for example, in the dramatic event of the flight into Egypt: a difficult trial indeed.

The Child Jesus with his Mother Mary and Saint Joseph form a simple yet profoundly radiant family icon. The light it radiates is a light of mercy and salvation for the whole world, a light of truth for every person, for the human family, and for every individual family. This light emanating from the Holy Family encourages us to offer human warmth in those family situations where, for various reasons, peace, harmony, and forgiveness are lacking.

An essential aspect of family life is respect for one another and the care taken not to harm or deprive others of their freedom. *"Love for others implies the joy of contemplating and valuing the beauty and sacredness of their personal being, which exists beyond my own needs."* God himself chose to live in a family, to experience the greatest and most beautiful affection that humanity can imagine.

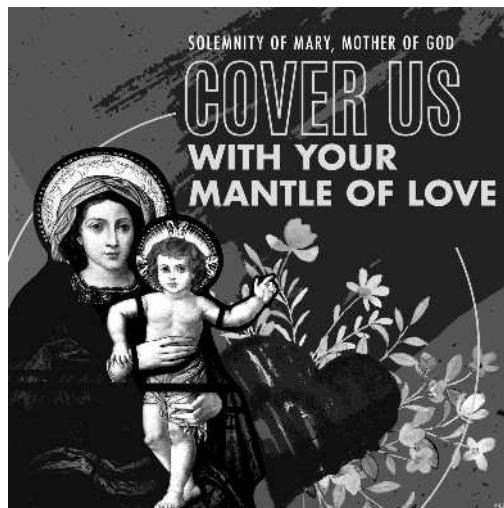
