





FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

First Sunday of Lent (A)

Dear Brothers and sisters,

With Ash Wednesday we started the sacred season of Lent, this important liturgical season lasts forty days, and it is a period significant in Scripture. This is the length of the flood in Genesis and the duration of Moses' fast before receiving the Ten Commandments. Even more significant is the length of Jesus' time in the desert before beginning his ministry. Lent is a time of awakening; an opportunity to 'begin anew'; an opportunity for renewal and commitment. Above all, it is a call to love as Jesus loved the Father and each one of us: continually and in self-giving. Lent is a time of sobriety, but not a somber time.

As Lent begins, the readings this weekend highlight our freedom to make choices. God gives us the freedom, out of love, to even make wrong choices, as Adam and Eve did in the first reading, when they succumbed to the serpent's seductive voice.

The Psalm 51 is the prayer of one who acknowledges his bad decisions, but seeks forgiveness, a pure heart and a firm spirit, promising in return to praise the Lord with joy.

In the second reading, Saint Paul said "when all was sin and shame, a second Adam came to the struggle and to the rescue" in the person of Jesus. We restore our friendship with God and our life with Him.

Lent is a good time to become more aware of the decisions we make in our daily lives. We can achieve this by dedicating a little more time each day to the Lord, accompanying him on his journey to Jerusalem and his Passion, and then to the resurrection at Easter.

Remember,

"God loves you, God loves me, God loves us"
