





FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Second Sunday of Lent A

Dear brothers and sisters,

In this second Sunday of Lent the liturgy presents us The Transfiguration of Jesus, and this is one of the most impactful and significant events recounted in the Synoptic Gospels. The three evangelists help us to witness an extraordinary moment in which Jesus reveals His Divine Glory to some of His closest disciples. This event not only confirms His identity as the Son of God, but also powerfully connects the Law and the Prophets with the presence of Moses and Elijah, with the new covenant He came to establish. Also, the event of the Transfiguration of Jesus is a reflection that translates into hope and strength in times of trial. Jesus' transformation reminds us that, through faith, we too are called to experience a personal metamorphosis that draws us closer to the image of Christ and that transformation is the invitation during this sacred season of Lent. As we walk into our Lenten journey, we are invited to a profound exercise in listening, and Jesus, by going up the mountain to pray, shows us the way: a moment of solitude with the Father, of closeness to Him, of openness to the divine mystery. Amidst so many voices calling to us, our mission as Christians is to discern the voice of the Lord, who speaks to us in His Word, in prayer, and in daily life.

The Transfiguration, as today's Gospel teaches us, is a foretaste of the glory that awaits us, but it is also an invitation to live that glory in our daily lives. On this Lenten journey, we are called to listen to Jesus, to contemplate His face, to allow ourselves to be transformed by His love, and to be bearers of hope in a world in need of light. May this Lenten season lead us to a true personal transfiguration, so that, when Easter arrives, we may be witnesses of the resurrection and the new life that Christ offers us.
