





FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Fourth Sunday of Lent (A)

Dear Brothers and sisters,

This fourth Sunday of Lent is known as, "Laetare Sunday" which means "Rejoice", because we have passed the halfway point of Lent. We take a moment to breathe amidst the penitential tone. Now we know that Easter is near. We continue to experience Lent as preparation for and the beginning of Easter. Christ is the light that continues to guide us through events such as the healing of the blind man in today's liturgy, which prepares us to joyfully contemplate the glory of the resurrection.

Last Sunday we focused on the baptismal symbol of water; now we encounter two more: oil and light. The First Book of Samuel tells us how the prophet Samuel anointed David as king of Israel. The Gospel of John presents Jesus as the light of the world, illuminating the eyes of a man born blind. And Saint Paul reminds us that we must always behave as children of light.

Jesus reveals to the healed blind man that He has come into the world for judgment, to separate the blind who can be cured from those who refuse to be healed, for they boast of being healthy. Indeed, the temptation to construct an ideological system of security is strong in humankind.

Dear brothers and sisters, let us be healed by Jesus, who wants to give us the light of God! Let us confess our blindness, our shortsightedness, and above all what the Bible calls the "great sin" (cf. Psalm 18:14): pride. May Mary Most Holy help us in this, for by giving birth to Christ in the flesh, she gave the world the true light.




Adoration and Stations of the Cross Friday March 20 in the Resource Center Chapel starting at 5 pm.
