† February 18

Living a Christ-Centered Life—6:30-8 p.m.

Join us for three nights of engaging talks and devotions. Fr. Brad Krawczyk, from St. Francis de Sales Seminary, will present two nights of talks that will help us to re-center our life with Christ. Father Sergio will lead our third night with our traditional Lenten devotions of Stations of the Cross and Eucharistic Adoration. Opportunity for confession will be available during the mission. Each night opens and closes with song and prayer with fellowship afterwards.

Second Sunday of Lent

† **March 7-8** Third Sunday of Lent

Items needed: body wash, mouthwash, chap stick, deodorant, soap, shampoo, conditioner, and hand sanitizer, disposable razors, shaving cream, toilet paper and Kleenex.

† **March 14-15** Fourth Sunday of Lent
Help provide 100 Easter Dinners to families in need.
Items needed: canned or bone in hams, boxed potatoes (au gratin, mashed, scalloped), boxes of Jello, cake mixes & frostings.

† **March 21-22** Fifth Sunday of Lent
