Light a Fire

Jesus, for all his faith in the Father's will and his life of witness to the ideals of peace and forgiveness, love and equality, was a realist.

The Hebrew Scriptures, including today's reading from the book of Jeremiah, were well known by Jesus. Jesus understood, long before he began his own public ministry, that God's prophets never received unanimous welcome. Their messages of repentance, reward, and re-calling to the covenant often backfired and landed them in exile, or, like Jeremiah, in the bottom of the cistern.

The words of Jesus in today's gospel are harsh ones. "I have come to light a fire ... I have come for division." One can perceive these words as threats or view them as a simple statement of truth. The Messiah who brought God's love, peace, justice and forgiveness was himself an object of hatred, revenge, injustice and violence.

Today, no less than in Jesus' time, gospel values can divide people, families and communities. They can still "light a fire."
