The lesson of today's gospel is clear: beware of becoming smug and complacent. Jerusalem and its temple were destroyed. But there is a new Jerusalem (first reading), and to the holy city God is drawing all the dispersed Jews with Gentiles from all parts of the world.

This is the moment of glory that the prophet Isaiah sees when the struggle between good and evil—not Jew and Gentile—is over and won.

Everyone who loves God and does good wins, folks from the strangest places, the entire ancient Gentile world as the Israelites knew it. That means no more broken world and shattered humanity; no greater, no lesser; no first, no last; no Jew, no Gentile; no Catholic, no Baptist; no capitalist, no socialist; just one contrite and cleansed humanity, bathed in the glory of God, together worshipping the one, same loving Lord.


