
MARRIAGE

Joseph

Joseph's understanding of God's will for him is clear and unadorned. His quiet acceptance is almost palpable as we stand on the brink of our own Christmas celebration and try to sort out what matters and what doesn't. The Isaian prophecy settles in Joseph's house and is welcome there. Joseph seeks no shortcuts. He knows what God is asking him to do and he follows his call.

The name of this child is given to him as it was given to Mary: "... you are to name him Jesus ..." The name Jesus is rooted in the Hebrew word that means "the Lord is salvation." In Joseph's acceptance, salvation settled over his roof when the sun rose the next day. This faith-filled, just man and quiet protector of Mary ushers us into our celebration of Christmas, God with us.
