Called to Holiness

The Holy Family is not a standard of comparison that would choose to apply to our own families, no matter how good they are. Joseph, Mary and Jesus are quite an extraordinary family from our point of view.

Perhaps to understand the Holy Family, we need to understand what holiness means. Today's readings give us some guidelines for becoming a holy family. Sirach points to the respect and honor with which the Lord asks us to treat our families; Paul spells out the attitudes we need to develop if our relationships are to be life-giving and Christian; the gospel shows how Jesus, Mary and Joseph protected each other and faced a crisis by listening to God's plan, a plan that calls us to love.


