# Gratitude

Do we today perhaps judge the nine lepers in our gospel too harshly? Were those nine, newly healed, liberated from the terrible isolation and stigma of their leprosy—were they ingrates?

Is it so inconceivable that, freed of illness, they should be taken with the newness of their skin, overjoyed at no longer having to announce themselves "unclean?" Is it so unbelievable that they, in their joy at Jesus' kindness, might forget to thank him?

Only those of us who have remembered to thank Jesus can pass judgment on those lepers who failed to return. Only those of us who have acknowledged the preciousness of life, whatever its struggles, can be indignant at the lepers' behavior.

The rest of us, though, must recognize the echo of our own gratitude in the leper's behavior. Perhaps we'll all be moved to express some long-overdue gratitude.





