- Treasury balance on hand \$1093.25. Candles were purchased for \$1553. Bake sale brought in \$470.
- Donation of \$250 for the bazaar was approved.
- Marge Fitzgerald reported on the success of the Rosary Rally. Thirty people attended, but because of the weather it was moved inside the church. She thanked everyone for their cooperation and would like it to be an annual event.
- Due to a conflict, the Cookie Walk has been changed to Sunday, December 15th after the 8:30 AM Mass. Alice Dumstorff is willing to take charge. Because of the cost of the buckets from previous years, plastic containers from the grocery store will be used. All Circle Chairs are asked to call their ladies to remind them to provide 3 dozen cookies. Bring them Saturday afternoon with set-up on Sunday morning. Coffee and rolls will be served after Mass for a free will offering. This will be the extra activity for Circle 1.
