ST. JOSEPH FINANCE ADVISORY COUNCIL met in the rectory on July 25, 2019, following the 5:30 pm Mass. Members present were: President, Fr. McLoud led an opening prayer and opened the meeting.

BUSINESS:

MINUTES from May 2, 2019 were reviewed. No corrections necessary.

FISCAL YEAR-END FINANCIAL REPORTS were reviewed and approved by the Finance Council.

BUDGET FOR 2019/20 was reviewed and approved by the Finance Council.

AUTHORIZATION for Directors to be signers on bank accounts was approved by the Finance Council.

FARM RENT: The consensus by the finance council was to leave the rent at the current rate. Fr. McLoud approved.

STEPS/SIDEWALK DAMAGE north and south of church. This bid increased to approximately \$6,344 as Becker Construction will now be tearing out the south steps and replacing them. They will do the work in August. The increase was accepted by Fr. McLoud & the Finance Council.

SIGNAGE AREA AND RECTORY STEPS – Still waiting on repair estimates for both.

GROUNDS EAST OF RECTORY & CHURCH: Dirt will be laid to fill several potholes.

GLOBE – New Globe requirements were discussed.

TOGETHER AS ONE (new DAA) was discussed. Our team will consist of Lori Cink, (leader); Lauri Arndorfer, (marketing); and Deb Trenary, (donor relations).

ST. JOSEPH CEMETERY: Discussion on trees by Grotto. Will be looked at and possibly taken out and seeded or new trees replanted.

FIREWORKS: Discussion on unauthorized people using our parking lot for some fireworks. This will be brought up with the city council.

Fr. McLoud accepted and approved all recommendations. He adjourned and closed with prayer.
