<u>FIRST SCHOOL MASS</u> - Our first ALL school Mass will be Friday, August 18th at 8AM. Please join us as we begin our school year together.

<u>USDA SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM</u> - At this time, all students will receive a Grab-N-Go snack in the morning and a Hot Lunch with a drink at no cost to parents as part of the Community Eligibility Provision ("CEP") under the National School Lunch Program. A letter with information about CEP and possibly additional benefits available was sent home last week. It can be returned to the school office or Diocesan office.

<u>IMPORTANT NEW YEAR PAPERWORK</u> – An envelope with 2023 / 2024 school paperwork will be sent home soon with students. Please return the envelopes with the paperwork completed ASAP.

<u>ART & PLANNER FEE</u> – If you have not already done so, please be sure to pay the \$40 art and planner fee per family as soon as possible.

SCHOOL ABSENCES – Please be sure to contact the school office by 7:30AM if your student will be absent on a given day. Completion of the St. Anthony Reentry After Absence Form or a note will be required upon the student's return to school. A copy of the form is attached to this newsletter. After 3 days, a physician's note / release is required to accompany the form.

VIRTUS is the brand name that identifies best practice programs designed to help prevent wrongdoing and promote right-doing within religious organizations. The VIRTUS programs empower organizations and people to better control risk and improve the lives of all those who interact with the Church. "Protecting God's Children for Adults" is training conducted by VIRTUS certified facilitators on the prevention of child sexual abuse. The training makes participants aware of the signs of child sexual abuse, the methods and means by which offenders commit abuse, and five easy steps one can use to prevent child sexual abuse. The Diocese requires all adults who enter the school building or are around school children in any capacity, must be in full compliance with the charter. This requires completed paperwork on file with the Diocese, attendance at a one-time Virtus Live Training session and maintenance of monthly online bulletins.
