40 DAYS FOR LIFE – FALL 2025

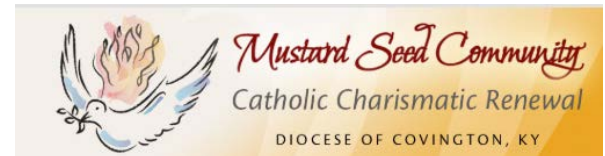
