Donation ideas include exercise equipment/clothing, tools, kid's toys (outside toys, stuffed animals, gaming consoles,

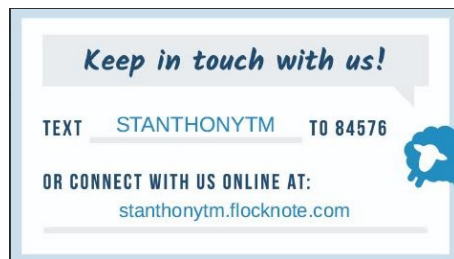
Legos), household items, tickets to sporting events or family outings, movie tickets and gift cards. We appreciate any and all donations and as always, thank you for your continued support.

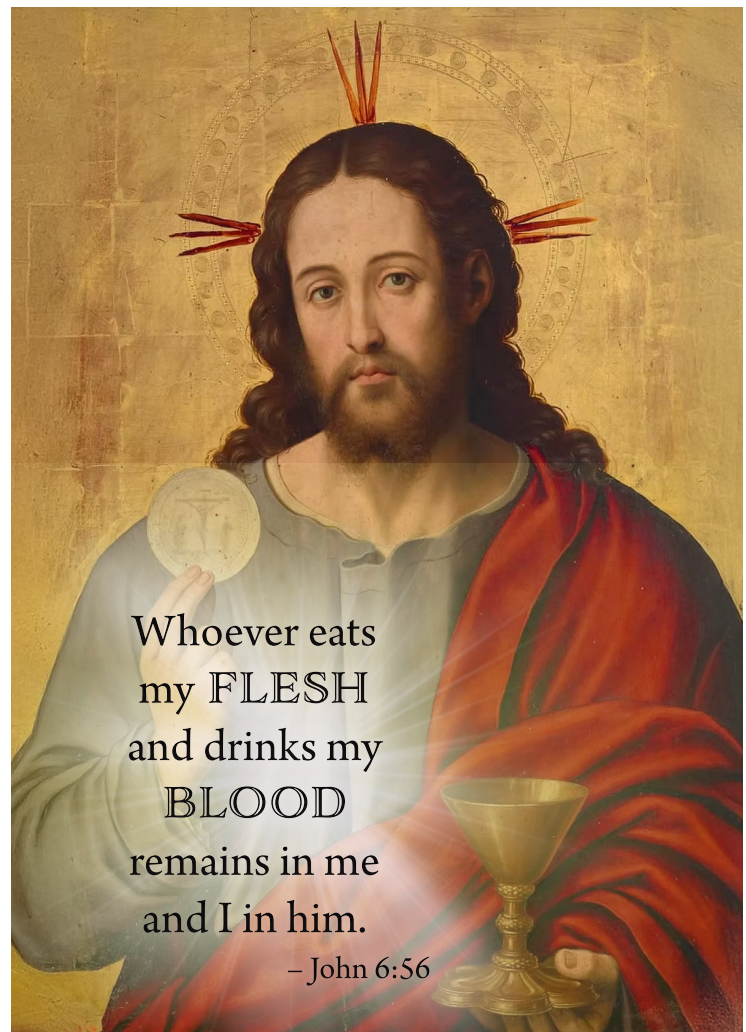

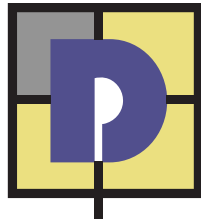
