This month the students of St. Anthony's Good Works club (5th-8th) will be volunteering at The Giving Tree of NKY, a local nonprofit that supplies foster children and foster families with essential items. The students will be sorting clothing and hygiene donations.

When a child enters foster care there is typically very little notice to the child or the foster family. The children come to their new foster home with little to no belongings. Foster families do their best to have supplies on hand, but they do not always know the age or needs of the child that comes into their care. Children can come into care in as little as a few hours notice. Contrary to popular belief, foster families do not have much support in the way of stipends in providing for the children. As a foster parent, I can tell you a lot comes out of pocket for these kiddos. Things can get expensive very quickly, especially for new and long-term placements.

On the back of this flyer is a list of essential items that will assist these children and families in their difficult time of transition. Please pray for these children, their birth families, and foster families, and social workers. If you are able to donate at this time, place your donations in the bin in the back of church or you can turn them into the school office, by December 11th.
