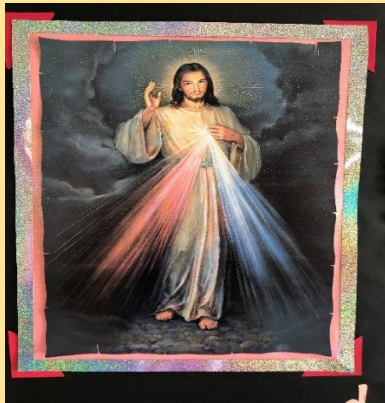


# ST. ANTHONY COUGAR CONNECTION
