PSR, (formally PREP) has no coordinator. Teresa Pikar contacted Holy Cross to send our students to their program. The cost is \$50 per student at Holy Cross. RCIA has no new members at this time.

Krista Braun- Recreation, Boosters, Forresters: No Reports at this time.

Lisa Bottom- School, ACUE: Lisa has resigned from Parish Council. Report given by Mary Carol Heidrich. The first day of school was on August 16th. Opening school mass was August 17th at 12:30. School masses will be every Friday at 12:30. The school has 50 students enrolled for the 2018-2019 school year. There were 48 students last school year. 4 graduated and 2 students were not returning. The school picnic was August 26th. ACUE- No Report.

Mary Ellen McDaniel- Social Outreach: MACC has had over 100 people in the 2 months of June and July. St. Vincent De Paul continued to collect money with no specifics of how much was collected. Anniversary celebration committee met on August 10th. The DVD has been started and coming along very well. Annie Mitchell from Sacred Heart Radio will be contacted for a possible parish visit.

Dan Pikar- Finance: Finance Committee met and everything was on track. Laura Funicelli has joined the committee and has been adding information into Quick Books. PDS should be done by August 30th and all involved with that are Dan Pikar, Blair Thompson and Laura Funicelli. The expenses for the 140th celebration will come out of the festival savings account. There are three financial accounts now which include a Parish account, School account and Gaming

account. DPAA has approximately \$770 owed but the parish has until the end of February to raise those funds.
