Brad Knochelmann- Maintenance: Rectory needs to be cleaned/updated. The carpet is figured to be at least 20 years old, couches need to be disposed of as well as several old desks. It was suggested to hire a company to come in and deep clean the rectory. The steps need to be redone at the rectory as well as repair the sidewalk.

The railing to the basement steps needs to be moved to the middle at the Parish Center.

Mary Carol- Faith Formation, Men's Group, PREP, RCIA:

PREP has not heard from anyone about interest in signing up for the Parish Religious Education Program. RCIA; Kim Bailey one man was interested in joining RCIA but had some difficulty joining online. Kim sent the link to him. There is currently no RCIA team, so we may depend on Holy Cross to fulfill that need as well.

Krista Braun- Recreation, Boosters, Forresters: Boosters are getting into the sports sign ups the week of September 10th. Sports equipment was ordered for the school and was delivered the week of September 3rd. Forresters will start their monthly skating parties in October.

September 14th was a Family Movie Night from 6:30 to ?. The movie will be shown in the cafeteria drive-in style- bring camp chairs and/or blankets and pillows to sit on. Come as early as 6:30 for pizza supper (\$1 a slice) and to get a good seat. The movie is due to begin at 7:30 with snacks and drinks available for purchase. September 23rd - Parish Grounds and Nature Center Clean-Up 11:00 - 2:00. We would like to spruce up the grounds for the upcoming HOMECOMING! We would like to weed the flower beds and make sure everything looks great! If we have enough help and time, we also have a Nature Center in the woods behind school. It includes a walking path and a gathering space with benches. It has become overgrown and needs some sprucing up as well. Help us make this great space enjoyable again! Pizza lunch will be provided.

Lisa Bottom- School, ACUE: Lisa thankfully decided to rescind her resignation from Council. No ACUE update. School has two field trips scheduled. October 9th, the Jungle Book from the Cincinnati Children's Theatre was coming to Fleming Hall. October 13th is the PTO Keeneland Bus Trip for adults. MAP testing will be done until the end of September. This testing occurs in the Fall, Winter and Spring. October 23rd is a field trip to see the Kentucky Symphony.

Mary Ellen McDaniel- Social Outreach: St. Vincent DePaul from May through August had expenditures of \$1880 in food, \$1029 in utilities, \$330 in rent, \$800 in clothing vouchers, and \$1075 in furniture vouchers. MACC is coming up this week of September 10th. Baby Blankets had no needs. It was discussed and decided to continue the Baby Blanket Ministry. CareNet baby bottles will start in October. Rosary for Life coming up in October. The parish will participate in the 40 Days for Life Campaign in October. Anniversary Meeting is Thursday, September 13th at 7pm.

Dan Pikar- Finance: Dan called the Diocese to see why the DPAA figure had changed. St. Anthony went from being \$770 away from our goal to now an \$1800 difference. School received a \$1500 grant for a music teacher. The financial statement was completed by Dan Pikar, Laura Funicelli and Blair Thompson and sent in with the moneys owed to the Diocese. It was discussed to possibly have someone come in to do the checks and balances to assist the parish secretary. Once Dan Pikar's term has ended on Parish Council, Laura Funicelli has volunteered to step into his position.

Judy Dornbusch- Evangelization: Judy checked on a couple of Bible studies for women. Sacred Heart was emailed again, but there has been no response yet for dates in October. She was asked about forming a Women's Prayer Group. A notice will be put in the bulletin after the Homecoming and would meet opposite the Men's Group.
