# Pete Manczyk

- 1. A Covington Deanery Pastoral Council meeting was held on Thursday, August 28 at Mother of God Church with Fr. Michael Comer (the new dean) leading the meeting. The emphasis was on a discussion on the state and health of Parish Councils across the Diocese (especially in the Covington Deanery). It was mentioned that the various Parish Councils have different numbers of members, different formats, and different roles. However, it was agreed that all Parish Councils should envision about what is possible in the parishes and figure out how to get there. The Bishop and the Diocesan Pastoral Council want to take steps to encourage the healthy and synodal development of the lay voice in Parish Councils by studying and encouraging best practices in cooperation with the pastors. Fr. Comer will set the time later for the next Covington Deanery Pastoral Council meeting.
- 2. Flocknote messages continue to be sent on a regular basis, including the "Diocese of Covington Media" and "Nugget from Fr. Ivan's Homily" emails.
- 3. Social Media messages continue to be posted to both Facebook and Twitter (X). While mostly Diocesan messages, we have started to include more parish content as well.
- 4. No update on the new website other than the next steps for Pete include training on the new management dashboard (maintenance is very different than the old website). Pete is hoping that Becki Walker and/or Mary Palmer will be able to join him in the training in the next month or so. After that, a schedule will be made to cut over to using the new website and disabling the old one.
- 5. There is a Church Renovation Video on the front page of the website. It is a slideshow of pictures showing the work that has been done so far.
- 6. The school website has been updated for the 2025-2026 content and is updated weekly for school news. The school has been asked to provide teacher photos and biographies for the website. This is a big gap for St. Anthony in comparison to other school websites. This will become even more important when going to the new website with the way school information is organized.

- 7. Pilgrimage online sign-up We are using a Flocknote form for sign-ups and creating a special communications group. Mary Palmer has been providing names from "Parish Center" sign-ups (the manual process) so that we have one list. As of this email, 35 have signed up with 12 open seats. Flocknote is NOT keeping track of who paid.
- 8. In September, the St. Anthony Men's Group suspended regular meetings due to the Latino Festival and the Pilgrimage. In October, the Men's Group will celebrate its 21<sup>st</sup> Anniversary and will put up the Pro-Life Crosses on Saturday, October 4 and take them down on Saturday, October 18.
