





## Society of Saint Vincent de Paul

The OLL Saint Vincent de Paul Conference recently had a breakfast meeting with Father Don Thimm as our guest. Imagine yourself at the table as you read the inspiring (paraphrased) message that he shared: "SVdP makes many connections with the larger community by advocating for the poor on a state and national level and by connecting friends in need to local services. The SVdP stores throughout the state remind us that our donated belongings become treasures to others. They are the source of funding to help those in need. We become ambassadors of the story of Jesus when making home visits and listening to neighbor's stories instead of telling and preaching. By forming relationships with our neighbors, we enter the DNA of God by doing the work of the gospel. We are like Jesus washing the feet of the disciples. The poor and vulnerable are so often the people who are judged. Instead of judging, we should be inspired by the courage and strength of the people met during home visits. As their stories are heard, their lives are changed, and Vincentians' lives are transformed, as lives were when Jesus did the same. It is a new experience of Christ outside of the church. It is holy, life-transforming work, a new way to discover the Lord. It heals wounded hearts. One of the geniuses of Fredrick Ozanam, the founder of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (in 1833), was that all of the baptized, not just those called to religious orders, were worthy of the mission to provide for the poor. If the church doesn't leave the building, the Eucharist is not as powerful as the Lord intended. The voice of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul may be small in the church, but it is a most important voice as we reach out to the last, the lost, the least and the lonely."
