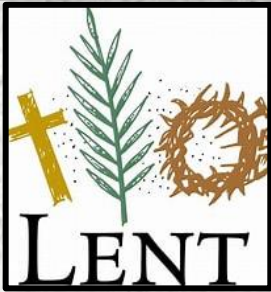

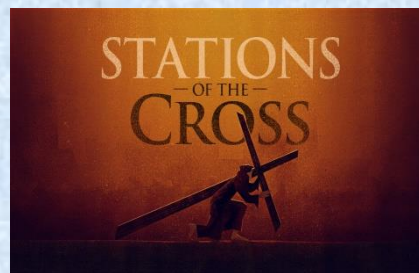

Cluster Youth Faith Formation News

How quickly these liturgical seasons go by. It seems that by the time we're finally finished fishing for needles out of our furniture, we're accepting ashes as atonement for our spiritual ailments. But all alliteration aside, the new year has fast approached and the season of Lent is here.

Now if you're like me, your New Year's resolutions last all of two weeks, but when it comes to Lent, I have a different motivation for making changes in my life. The word "Lent" gets its original meaning from an Old English word "*lencten*" which means the lengthening of days or "springtime." When I think of springtime, I think of spring cleaning and starting out fresh and new. Lent is my time to declutter the items in my life that take my attention away from God. It's the time to reorganize my priorities. Lent is the time to clean my heart of sin, so that I can truly feel God's presence in my life. When you empty your lives of the things that don't matter, you have much more room for God to move in.

So far this year, the younger students have been learning about the nine fruits and seven different gifts of the Holy Spirit in their prayer services, and about the role of the Holy Spirit in their lives. They've also learned about the need to call on their guardian angel daily to help protect them from making wrong choices and guide them toward Jesus.

The older students have continued to learn about salvation history, including the fall of Lucifer and the angels, but also our hope in Christ's death and resurrection. We were honored to have Archbishop Grob come out in January and give a talk to the families that bookended this theme. He talked about his experience with exorcism, demonology, and how to protect ourselves. He told the students that Satan is like a vicious dog on a chain. If you stay away from the dog, you are fine. If you are curious and approach, you'll probably get bit. If you don't think the dog exists, the consequences could be devastating. But there was great reassurance that as long as we remember God has power over darkness and we stay in the light of God, we need not worry.

The Mission Trippers are continuing to prepare for their trip to Knoxville, TN. This year we'll be sharing a bus with St. John XXIII in Port Washington to help cut costs. They also have a few more fundraisers coming up with a stock sale the weekend of February 21 and 22 (at all Masses) and a Pancake Breakfast on March 8 at Holy Cross. We are always thankful for the generous support we receive for these life-changing trips.

In March, the 2nd graders will have their Bread Day Retreat to help get them ready for their First Communion. In April, the Confirmation students will be making their weekend retreat to Holy Hill. Please continue to pray for our youth during this time of preparation and discernment.

We are also happy to announce that we will be doing VBS again this summer (contingent on volunteers). If you'd like to be part of the VBS team, please contact me at either parish office.

Wishing you a Lenten season of renewal, hope and a strengthening of faith.

Baptism Class: If you are a new parent or expecting a child, and it has been three years since your last child was baptized, you need to take a class before having your child baptized. Consider taking the class while you are pregnant. Contact Deb Hamm to set up a class.

Hospital Visits: Please remember if you or an immediate family member is hospitalized and you'd like the parish to know, you should call your parish office. The privacy laws make it very difficult for us to know if someone is in the hospital. Even if someone at the hospital says they will notify your parish, they don't always do so.

Adult Sacraments: If you or someone you know would like to become Catholic, maybe now is the time! Also, if you never received the **Sacrament of Confirmation** as a teenager, you could still do that. **Contact Deb Hamm for information on what is entailed in completing these Sacraments.**
