From the Desk of the Principal

These certainly are crazy times! As a reminder, we have several school parents, six students and two teachers out of school this week in quarantine. We were notified Friday afternoon that someone at the BBQ Bonanza tested positive and was considered infectious on the day of the event. (As a point of reference, people are infectious 48-72 hours prior to the onset of symptoms.) All of our staff and students are COVID-19 free right now; however, we are being required to quarantine because of our close contact with the positive case.

Unfortunately, I was one of the teachers who was contact traced. I will be working from home until October 26th and teaching my students virtually. Mrs. Pawling was also contact traced because of her work at the BBQ event. We are both feeling fine and will be quarantining and watching for symptoms. Our thoughts and prayers are with all of our families affected by this. Please pray for healing and patience as we navigate the week ahead!

A huge shout-out to all who took the time to join our Catholic Schools Walk this past Saturday at Waubedonia Park. It was a great show of support for our school. 


FALL FESTIVAL

Items needed this week are: No added sugar Cereal, Canned Fruit, Spaghetti Sauce, Progresso Soup, Chili, Snack Pack Pudding, Pancake Syrup, Graham Crackers, Toilet Paper, Shampoo, and Dish Soap.

Daily Home Health Screening

If someone in your household is symptomatic and being tested for COVID-19, your child(ren) must stay home!

- Are you showing symptoms of COVID-19? (high fever, cough, difficulty in breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, body aches, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, chills, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)
- Have you been in contact with someone confirmed or suspected of having COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Have you returned from travel to areas with community spread of COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Were medications used to lower you or your child's temperature?
- Are you limiting the number of people you come in contact with as they abide by "Safer at Home" to prevent the spread of COVID-19?
