Safe Environment

- Did You Know... Criminal Background Checks are conducted on every priest, deacon, parish director, employee, and volunteer working with minors in active ministry in parishes and schools in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.
- Did You Know... In 2020 in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, over 70 Safe Environment Education Sessions were conducted with over 1,800 adults trained in identifying signs of abuse and neglect, over 3,800 criminal background checks were conducted on clergy, employees, and volunteers, and over 50,000 children were trained in Safe Environment topics.
- Did You Know... All clergy, employees and volunteers are instructed to contact local law enforcement or Child Protective Services immediately if they are made aware of a child being sexually abused. All bishops, priests, deacons lay parish/school staffs, and volunteers are required to follow the mandatory reporting laws of the State of Wisconsin.
- Did You Know... All seminarians in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee undergo criminal background checks, Safe Environment Education training in child abuse prevention, psychological evaluation, classes and workshops on human sexuality, and mandatory reporter training.
- Did You Know... The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has a Victim Assistance Coordinator that has assists survivors of sexual abuse to navigate through the process of reporting abuse and receiving counselling services. The Victim Assistance Coordinator can be reached at (414) 758-2232.
- Did You Know... No priest or deacon with a substantiated allegation of sexual abuse of a minor can or will ever serve as a priest or deacon in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Did You Know... In the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, a Diocesan Review Board reviews allegations against clergy involving abuse of a minor and helps hold our diocese accountable.

Daily Home Health Screening

If someone in your household is symptomatic and being tested for COVID-19, your child(ren) must stay home!

- Are you showing symptoms of COVID-19? (high fever, cough, difficulty in breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, body aches, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, chills, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)
- Have you been in contact with someone confirmed or suspected of having COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Have you returned from travel to areas with community spread of COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Were medications used to lower you or your child's temperature?
- Are you limiting the number of people you come in contact with as they abide by "Safer at Home" to prevent the spread of COVID-19?
- If you are in need of a test, you can register at www.curative.com. These are free oral swab tests at the Ozaukee and Washington County Fairgrounds.
