During the month of September, we worked on PATIENCE. Our students and staff did an excellent job practicing patience. During October, we worked on being RESPECTFUL. During the month of November, we worked on GRATITUDE. In December, we worked on sharing JOY. At DSCS, January reminded us to let our light shine with SELF-CONTROL, and in February we let our light shine with FORGIVENESS. Last week we submitted a grant to the Bruce Krier Foundation to help us improve security at DSCS. Our focus of the grant was on more secure doors and windows. The idea for the grant came about because our DSCS Safety Committee reviewed the results of our building safety report from the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office. We are always looking for ways to ensure the safety of our students, staff and parish members. We should hear back in May about the grant- say a prayer for us!

At DSCS, we take safety very seriously! Four members of our School Safety Team attended a two day school safety training in Wisconsin Dells. Our training was presented by the i love you guys Foundation. We reviewed important security measures and we were able to participate in a reunification simulation. The training was excellent and has helped to prepare our team for the task of establishing our reunification plan. Our entire staff also participated in Stop the Bleed Training during our teacher inservice on February 27th.
